



**LITTLETON HOCKEY ASSOCIATION
Littleton Hawks and Colorado 14ers**

**Dual Rostering Policy
2026-2027 Season**

The following provisions apply to participation in hockey programming with Littleton Hockey Association (“LHA”).

LHA understands that parents may have questions regarding a player’s ability to roster on more than one team during the season. More options are becoming available for players to participate in tournament-only teams, out-of-state teams, non-national bound teams, and the like. In response, Colorado Amateur Hockey Association (“CAHA”) has modified applicable policies and procedures, expanding dual-rostering authorization in some circumstances and limiting authorization in others.

At the same time, LHA’s Dual Rostering Policy considers not only individual player interests, but the interests of the various LHA teams that may be involved as well. LHA teams rely on consistent attendance and commitment to each other. This leads to a strong team dynamic and a successful path towards development for all players. LHA balances the desire for individual flexibility while keeping the collective needs of all players, coaches and teams in mind.

The following provisions govern dual rostering within LHA:

Littleton Hawks Tier II Players

- Littleton Hawks Tier II players may only be committed to one CAHA Member Association and one high school team at a time.
- Littleton Hawks Tier II players are authorized to dual roster on one LHA National Tournament Bound (“NTB”) team AND a high school NTB team at the same time. This authorizes all Littleton Hawks Tier II players to dual roster with a Colorado High School Activities Association (“CHSAA”) high school team. Littleton Hawks Tier II players are able to participate in playoffs and USAH Nationals with both teams.
 - Colorado Prep Hockey League (“CPHL”) teams are classified as Rec Teams, not high school teams.
 - High Plains Hockey League (“HPHL”) teams are classified as non-NTB teams.

- Littleton Hawks Tier II players are authorized by CAHA to dual roster with one LHA NTB team and one non-LHA non-NTB team at the same time. Although CAHA expressly authorizes such dual rostering, LHA generally discourages its Tier II players from doing so, due to the difficulties that such dual rostering can cause to the player's LHA NTB team. In the event a player decides to dual roster, the expectation is that the player will prioritize his or her LHA NTB team commitments over those of the non-NTB team. Failure to do so may result in adverse but non-disciplinary consequences on the player at the discretion of the LHA NTB team head coach, such a loss of playing time or placement on a different line.
- Dual rostering by Littleton Hawks Tier II players is not authorized in other circumstances.
- Dual rostering may be subject to additional CAHA approval requirements.

Colorado 14ers Tier II Players

- Colorado 14ers Tier II players may only be committed to one CAHA Member Association and one high school team at a time.
- Colorado 14ers Tier II players are authorized to dual roster on one Colorado 14ers NTB team AND one high school NTB team at the same time. This authorizes all Colorado 14ers Tier II players to dual roster with one CHSAA high school team. Colorado 14ers Tier II players are able to participate in playoffs and USAH Nationals with both teams.
 - CPHL teams are classified as Rec Teams, not high school teams.
 - HPHL teams are classified as non-NTB teams.
- Colorado 14ers Tier II players are authorized to dual roster on one Colorado 14ers NTB team AND one Littleton Hawks NTB team at the same time. However, they are only allowed to participate in playoffs and USAH Nationals with one team. Players must declare with which team they will advance through playoffs December 31. Players may continue to practice with the other team until the start of CAHA State Playoffs.
- Colorado 14ers Tier II players are authorized to dual roster on one Colorado 14ers NTB team AND one Littleton Hawks non-NTB team at the same time, subject to approval of both the LHA Hockey Director and the Colorado 14ers Hockey Director.
- Colorado 14ers Tier II players are authorized by CAHA to dual roster with one Colorado 14ers NTB team and one non-LHA non-NTB team at the same time. Although CAHA expressly authorizes such dual rostering, LHA generally discourages its Tier II players from doing so, due to the difficulties that such dual rostering can cause to the player's Colorado 14ers NTB team. In the event a player decides to dual roster, the expectation is that the player will prioritize her Colorado 14ers NTB team commitments over those of the non-NTB team. Failure to do so may result in adverse but non-disciplinary consequences on the player at the discretion of the Colorado 14ers NTB team head coach, such a loss of playing time or placement on a different line.
- Dual rostering by Colorado 14ers Tier II players is not authorized in other circumstances.
- Dual rostering may be subject to additional CAHA approval requirements.

Other Littleton Hawks and Colorado 14ers Players

- All other (non-Tier II) Littleton Hawks and Colorado 14ers players may only be committed to one CAHA Member Association and one high school team at a time.
- All other (non-Tier II) Littleton Hawks and Colorado 14ers players are authorized to dual roster on one LHA team AND one high school NTB team at the same time. This authorizes all Littleton Hawks and Colorado 14ers players to dual roster with one CHSAA high school team.
- All other (non-Tier II) Colorado 14ers players are authorized to dual roster on one Colorado 14ers non-NTB team AND one LHA non-NTB team at the same time, subject to approval of both the LHA Hockey Director and the Colorado 14ers Hockey Director.
- All other (non-Tier II) Littleton Hawks and Colorado 14ers players are authorized to dual roster on one LHA team AND one CPHL team at the same time.
- All other (non-Tier II) Littleton Hawks and Colorado 14ers players are authorized to dual roster on one LHA team AND one HPHL team at the same time.
- Dual rostering by other Littleton Hawks or Colorado 14ers players is not authorized in other circumstances.

8U Players

- The provisions of this Dual Rostering Policy shall not apply to 8U players at LHA.
- LHA shall not otherwise restrict dual rostering by 8U Littleton Hawks or Colorado 14ers players.
- Dual rostering of 8U players may be subject to additional CAHA requirements or limitations.

Notification Requirements

Any player who desires to dual roster must provide written notification as soon as possible to the LHA Hockey Director or the Colorado 14ers Hockey Director, as appropriate. Such written notification must be provided BEFORE the player registers with or commits to the non-LHA team.

Please contact the LHA Hockey Director or the Colorado 14ers Hockey Director, as appropriate, with any questions regarding this Dual Rostering Policy.

Violations

If it is determined that an LHA player has dual rostered in a manner that violates this Policy, such player may be immediately removed from all LHA team rosters and all funds will be forfeited to LHA, subject to applicable refund policy provisions. Players will still be responsible for payment of the entire balance of registration fees and team fees to LHA, subject to applicable refund policy provisions.
