17th Annual Winterfest Jamboree – December 11-13, 2026

1. **Age Classification:** 8 & Under – Advanced, Intermediate and Beginner
2. **Location:** The Ice Ranch, The Edge Ice Arena & Elev802
3. **Entry Fee:** The cost of the Jamboree for all levels will be posted to the LHA Website. The entry fee must be paid online under the Tournament section of LHA's Website (www.littletonhockey.com). The entry fee is non-refundable once your team is accepted into the Jamboree. There is no admission fee for the spectators.
4. **Rosters:** All rosters will be due 2 weeks prior to the jamboree
5. **General:** All players must be registered with USA Hockey. LHA follows all 2025 - 2029 USA Hockey Rules. This is a USA Hockey Sanctioned Tournament and the SafeSport Program Protocol will be adhered to.
6. **Credentials:** A manager or coach must present complete credentials prior to their first Jamboree game. LHA requires each team to produce a USA Hockey 1-T Roster

A minimum of 8 teams at each age division will be accepted. Any team traveling to Colorado whose state affiliate requires a travel permit must present this permit by email prior to the start of the jamboree and when the team checks in.

7. **Game Format:** Advanced and Intermediate games will be played 4v4 with a goalie on half ice and an intermediate net. Beginner games will be played 4v4, no goalie and cross-ice on a mini-net. The start of the game will consist of a 2-minute warm up and a running 26-minute period with a buzzer every 90 seconds (1:30 minutes) for a line change. Each team will play six 26-minute games. Time-outs are not permitted. Each team will supply one coach on the ice to "referee". No score will be kept. Game pucks (blue) will be provided. These games will count towards the maximum number of games allowed per ADM policies at U8.

8. **Jamboree Format:** There will be no championship or consolation games.
9. **Jerseys:** Please note the color of jerseys on application.
10. **Neck guards** are required for all players at all levels.
11. **Benches:** Only USA Hockey certified coaches and players are allowed on the bench. All players on the bench must wear a helmet including a full face-mask pursuant to the USA Hockey rules. One coach from each team will be responsible for officiating the games. Coaches must be USAH certified. LHA may allow older USAH registered players on the ice to volunteer and officiate
12. **Tie-Breakers:** There are no tie breakers as score will not be kept.
13. **Reporting Times:** Teams must be ready to play 5 minutes prior to scheduled game time. Teams must follow the USA Hockey SafeSport Locker Room Policy.
14. **Disputes/Refusal to Play/Pointstreak:** There are no protests for game times. There should be no disputes over results as the score is not kept. If a team refuses to play a scheduled game, their payment will be forfeited and removed from the tournament for all remaining games. No games will be posted to Pointstreak.
15. **Damage to the Facilities:** Should any player or team willfully damage any property in the facility, all costs for repair or replacement shall be paid by the team concerned. Arrangements for restitution shall be made immediately with the rink management. Any profanity or abusive behavior towards rink personnel will result in an ejection from the rink and the jamboree.
16. **Game Results:** Games will NOT be posted on CAHA's electronic scoring system.
17. **Locker Rooms:** Locker Rooms will be available. It is the responsibility of the coach(s) and/or manager to monitor the locker rooms per USA Hockey SafeSport. Please have a representative present a minimum of 20 minutes prior to your scheduled ice session. Teams may enter a locker room 15 minutes before their scheduled session. It is recommended that players come dressed for their team's scheduled events.

Note: Consumption of food and beverage is not allowed in the locker rooms.

18. REQUIRED per CAHA policies, section 20.6.a.

Any Team which enters a tournament and fails to appear on time for a scheduled Game or who fails to provide a valid 1-T roster to the Tournament Director prior to the first Game of the tournament will be subject to:

- 1) Forfeit all tournament Games as determined by the Tournament Director.

2) Pay for all expenses, including but not limited to Referee fees and ice costs for each forfeited Game.

3) Denied entry in any Colorado tournaments for the remainder of the season and in the case of a CAHA team, any approved travel permits will be rescinded.
