They asked for purple skirts for this season 50 skirts \$3,249.50, 7 goalie/players short \$524.93 total \$3,774.43. Chaska has a new girls booster club they are doing flocking as a fundraiser. They will be doing a salt and woodchip sale with the boy's lacrosse club. They also brought up the Morgan's Message would like \$1,500 for 100 shirts with the Hawk, Storm and C3 logs for all the players. This would be done at the Chaska/Chanhassen Girls game at Chaska HS. Eric O said that we could look at a corporate sponsorship. Logan D meet with her booster club she had no request at this time. They would use the money for teacher nights. Jon would like an inflatable goalie for JV and more training tools.**
