- I. Welcome **Meeting called to order by President Bryant C 7:08 PM.**
- II. Crossbar Feedback & Update (Henry) **Crossbar is up and running.**
- III. Winter Clinic (Try Lax) (Eric, Matt, Penny, Adam)
  - a. Registration **35 players 2-K boys, 9-1<sup>st</sup> 4 girls 5 boys, 8-2<sup>nd</sup> 3 girls 5 boys, 9-3<sup>rd</sup> 5 girls 4 boys, 1-4<sup>th</sup> boy, 4-5<sup>th</sup> 1 girl 4 boys, 1-6<sup>th</sup> girl, 1-7<sup>th</sup> girl, 0-8<sup>th</sup>**
  - b. Coaches **Matt is working with Jon and Chris to supply players and coaches to run this. Penny will work with Lauren to get this set-up.**
  - c. Equipment (Balls, Sticks, Cones) **We have 43 boys sticks, and 29 girls sticks.**
  - d. **Would like to have board members to attend to help answer questions and keep control.**
- IV. GNLL Spring Season Plan Update – (Eric & Penny)
  - a. Update from GNLL Meeting (Boys) **10U will be equal teams. They are open to look at for the 2026 season. They will help teams play stronger teams during the spring season.**
  - b. Update from GNLL Meeting (Girls) **all levels will be equal and match play ability between associations. Penny talked to MSLax to have 14UB play GNLL instead of MSLax to get a better level of playing.**
- V. Season Registration Numbers for boys & Girls (Henry) **We have 19 boys: 3-14U, 5-12U, 5-10U, 7-8U, 0-6U. We have 9 girls: 1-14U, 1-12U, 3-10U, 5-8U, 0-6U.**
  - a. Girls Program Update/Needs (Penny & Adam) **Penny will be talking to Adam D about coaches.**
- VI. Boys Program Update/Needs (Eric & Matt)
  - a. 10U Boys A/B **YLM approved. Teams might have to travel longer distances for games.**
  - b. Other YLM season updates **YLM will work with 6U split boys and girls. They will help schedule the boy's side for games. YLM will also do true B teams during the season instead of just the tournament for at 12U & 14U. YLM will have A, B1 & B**

- teams. Teams might have to travel longer distances for games. Tournaments will not do A & B teams we will need to make balance teams for those games only.
- c. Boy's tournaments 8U-14UB do Wayzata and Shakopee. 14UA one tournament would be Shakopee or PL. Shakopee has less club tournament conflicts. Girls will do the same tournaments. 14U girls would do PL for their 2<sup>nd</sup> tournament. We will see how the spring season goes. We might look at making the Wayzata tournament would be a spring girl and then have 2 summer tournaments starting next year.
- d. Spring skills clinic in Jan at the ECC Dome. 1<sup>st</sup> hour goalie/faceoff 2<sup>nd</sup> hour shooting and 3<sup>rd</sup> on 1v1 or 2v2 situations. This allows players to attend more sessions. Each session will be billed separately. Penny needs to check with the HS coaches to see if they have enough coaches to run the clinics. Cost for each session will be \$25
- VII. Player Development - (Brian/Colin)
  - a. Into Schools They have everything ready to work with the schools.
- VIII. Safety Director Updates (Sam) – Need for paramedics Henry sent Sam the information for Heed Medical for her to setup a contract for EMT's for the season. 12U & 14U boys and girls.
  - a. Paramedic Scheduling, Med Kits, Season Readiness
- IX. Equipment (Darren & Brian) Brian will be ordering the balls for C3, Both Boys HS teams and Chan HS girls. We have 10 inflatable goalies. They will set up a google form for checking out the goalies.
