

What is RaiseRight?

Raise Right, formerly known as Scrip, is a gift card fundraising program. It's easy and it works! By using gift cards to pay for everyday (and not so everyday) expenses, each participant in your program can earn over \$1000 each year. No selling. No extra time. No extra money.

What gift cards are there?

Raise Right has paired with hundreds of brand companies and offers different incentives for each. Some familiar ones are Kohls, Panera, Kwik Trip, Amazon, Target, Chipotle, etc.

How do I earn money?

Raise Right offers a certain percentage of the amount of the gift card purchased as money back.

Do I get to keep all the funds I have earned?

No, Kenosha Komets will give each participant 90% of their earnings, the remaining 10% is used to cover fees from the program.

How do I get that money?

Raise Right runs from July 1st- June 30th each year. During the first week of July we receive the records from Raise Right letting us know how much you have earned for the past year. You will then be credited that dollar amount directly to your fall hockey fees!

How do I sign up?
