## **DESCRIPTION OF PARENT VOLUNTEER POSITIONS**

**Coach/Assistant Coach:** Attend all practices and games. Assist the Manager by following his/her instructions for working with players.

**Team Parent and Pictures:** Attend Team Parent Meeting on Monday, January 27, 2025 at the TABB Boardroom. “Veteran” Team Moms will meet at 10:00AM; “New” Team Moms will meet at 11:00AM. Assist Manager with team communications. Communicate directly with Team Parent Coordinator, Laura Zinniger, [tabbteammom46@gmail.com](mailto:tabbteammom46@gmail.com). Make sure ALL positions are filled and carried out by parent volunteers. Pass out picture order form to each family on the team. Send out reminder emails prior to Picture Day. Each player will need to be in full uniform (shirt, pants, hat, belt and socks) and bring the completed picture envelope. Distribute pictures when available.

**Team Page:** Responsible for designing and submitting team page for the yearbook. Player names and numbers, creative graphics and photos are encouraged. Deadline for the page is April 11, 2025. Submit pages to [tabbyearbook22@gmail.com](mailto:tabbyearbook22@gmail.com). Team pages must be submitted in PDF format.

### **Roles for Games**

**Scorekeeper:** One or two parents will volunteer to keep the GameChanger for managers (Pinto, Mustang, and Bronco divisions).

**Scoreboard Operator:** One parent from the home team to check out the scoreboard remote at the snack shack and operate the scoreboard on the field from the stands (Mustang and Bronco fields).

**Pitch Counter:** One parent will keep track of pitches thrown by every pitcher for both teams during the game.

**Field Parents:** Two or three parents to help prepare the fields at the beginning and conclusion of each game. This is an extremely valuable necessity for managers and coaches whose focus should be on preparing the team for the upcoming game.



## LIVE SCAN POLICY

*The safety of our participants shall always be our primary goal!*

TABB has adopted a **MANDATORY** background check policy that will be conducted through the California Department of Justice. **Safe and Secure**, located in Torrance, administers formal background checks, via the "LIVESCAN" System. **The nominal cost for this service is \$20.00 (cash/Zelle)/\$21.00 (charge)**. ALL managers, coaches, and board members, as well as anyone else having contact with the players, must participate in this program. **All managers MUST BE cleared by Live Scan no later than their first official practice and all other volunteers MUST BE cleared by Opening Day.**

## 2025 TABB Snack Shack Info

Director of Snack Shack: Jennifer Phillips

Welcome to the 2025 Season! My name is Jenn Phillips and this is my 2nd season as the director of TABB Snack Shack. I am still learning the ropes and am hopeful for another fun and successful year. Please take a moment to read through our Snack Shack operations. I have tried to include as much as I can!

- TABB Snack Shack is open weekday evenings and all-day Saturday and Sunday throughout our regular season. My goal is that if there is a game playing at TABB, the snack shack will be open!
- Two 3-hour shifts will be required (from a parent or a family representative 16 yrs. and older) per player with the exception of T-Ball. T-Ball will require one 3-hour shift.
- Shifts are weekdays between 4:30 pm. - 7:30 pm. and weekends between 8:30 am. - 6:30 pm
- Shifts consist of preparing food before opening, serving food and drinks, handling money, restocking products, washing dishes, and removing trash. Closing responsibilities include storing away food, cleaning counters and equipment, sweeping and mopping the floors.
- We are requiring T-Ball parents to volunteer 1 shift per child or buy out of their shift.
- We will be using *Sign-up Genius* for scheduling of shifts. This allows for you to work around school/work schedules. The Sign-up Genius will be released shortly after the schedules are released. We urge you to sign up ASAP for availability.

**GRILL SHIFTS:** The snack shack offers hot, made-to-order options which means each shift offers a grill shift. No experience is necessary and we will orient you so you are comfortable. Grill shift must be covered by adult 18 or over.

TABB is offering 2 options:

**BUY-OUT:** This fee will excuse you from being expected to work in the Snack Bar during the regular season. **Please see Jenn Phillips at the parent meeting with your payment.** We can accept cash, check or credit card or give it to your Team mom at your team practice. Buy-outs must be received before uniforms can be distributed. **If the snack shack fee is not paid and your child does not have a uniform they will not be able to play.**

**DEPOSIT:** Provide checks payable to TABB in the amounts required at Parent Meeting to Jenn Phillips or give it to your Team Mom at your team practice. Deposits must be received before uniforms can be distributed.



- Deposit checks will remain uncashed and returned to you on the day of each completed shift and uncashed checks will be kept in a safe at TABB.
- Once you schedule your shift, you are responsible for that shift.
- Parents who are planning to work in the Snack Bar (for the first time) I urge you to walk through the snack bar on TABB Clean Up day, February 1st or 8th. I will use this opportunity to answer any questions and show you the work environment. You are also welcome to contact me at 310-735-5364 with any questions you have.

\*\*\* If your shift is missed without proper coverage, your remaining checks will be deposited, and your remaining regular season shifts will be covered by paid workers.\*\*\*

We recognize having multiple children in any sport can add up quickly, so we are offering a reduction in our Snack Bar Fee to families with multiple players. All money collected is used for food and beverage, snack bar supplies, restroom supplies, maintenance, utility costs, and paid workers.

## **TABB Parking Plan**

### **Operating Hours**

Monday through Friday: 4PM-8PM. Saturday: 9AM -7:30PM. Sunday: 11AM-7:30PM.

During normal operating hours, **all** access gates to the field shall be open. This will prevent any one alley-way from being overburdened. With four means of ingress and egress, any one gate will not be overused.

**Gate # 1 (Bottom of Doris Way hill)**, will remain closed throughout the season.

**Gate # 2 (Carol Dr. & Doris Way)**, will be used as an **entry or exit point**, being the preferred gate for our **player drop-off area** between the Mustang and Bronco outfields. This area is near a walkway leading to the Main Snack Shack allowing access to both diamonds.

**Gate # 3 (Reese Rd. & Doris Way)**, will remain closed throughout the season.

**Gate # 4 (Sharynne Lane & Doris Way)**, which leads to the main parking lot, (See attached plot plan), will be used as an **entering and exiting point for parking** in our main parking lot. **Please note this parking lot is for handicap parking, managers, and snack shack personnel only.** Also, children like to play in this alleyway, so **PLEASE** drive slowly.

#### **Pinto Field Parking at St. Lawrence**


There is NO PARKING at St. Lawrence. Any cars parked on the basketball courts or along the T-ball field will be towed at the owner's expense.

Should there be any issues relative to parking in any of the lots; the President of TABB shall be the contact person (tabbpres@gmail.com).




This plan is to be used during normally scheduled games, playoffs or All-Star Tournaments.

## USA Bats

In conjunction with USA Baseball and its other participating national member organizations, PONY Baseball has adopted the new USA Baseball bat standard (USABat). Effective January 1, 2018, with the exception of -3 (BBCOR certified), all other 2 1/4" and 2 5/8" barrel bats with a minus factor of (-5, -7, -9, etc.), must be USABat certified with the USABat licensing stamp on the bat in order to be used for league and tournament play. All 2 1/4" and 2 5/8" minus factor bats -5, -7, -9, etc. used in 2017 will be illegal to use in 2018.

Here is what the approved USA bat stamp looks like:



Bats with a USSSA stamp are illegal in PONY Baseball:



Tee ball bats are not required to undergo lab testing to receive approval under the USABat program. PONY does require that tee ball bats must carry the USA Baseball mark accompanied by the following text: "Only For Use With Approved Tee Ball Bats." If you already have a tee ball bat you would like to continue using, to be compliant with PONY you can purchase a USA Bat sticker directly from USA Baseball and place it on your bat. TABB also has a limited number of stickers available to purchase.

Tee ball bats manufactured after the new rule was adopted will already include the USABat Baseball mark.
