Pg. 20 Rink Rats Fees Everyone on the ice must have a USA hockey membership, be a member of the high school hockey team, Papermaker team. People outside of our Mosinee Hockey Club must pay a fee determined during season prep and sign a liability form.	Update name to Beer League? • Adults playing with under 21 players who want to have alcoholic beverages during game. Ie. Dads playing with children and wanting a beer during the game. • Add language to liability form re: use of alcohol during ice rental? No current language stating whether or not alcohol is allowed during ice rental time. Current rules only state that alcohol is prohibited during youth games. (pg. 23, Special Rules) • Utilize a flat fee at time of registration instead of pay per game. Ie. \$20 for season, regardless of # of games you play?
Pg. 25 Locker Room Policy Mosinee Youth Club has predictable and limited use of locker rooms and changing areas (e.g., generally 30-45 minutes before and following practices and games). This allows for direct and regular monitoring of locker room areas. While constant monitoring inside of locker rooms and changing areas might be the most effective way to prevent problems, we understand that this would likely make some players uncomfortable and may even place our staff at risk for unwarranted suspicion.	Update Language to adhere to WAHA policy. LOCKER ROOM POLICY It is the policy of WAHA and USA Hockey that coaches are responsible for the supervision of the locker room at all times. All WAHA Member Programs must have at least one coach in the locker room monitoring locker room conduct during all team events to ensure the supervision and the proper conduct of the players. The coach must ensure that another coach or a screened and Safe Sport trained adult be present in the locker room at all times in case the coach must step out. Any player entering a locker room before the coach is in the locker room is subject to disciplinary action which includes loss of locker room privileges resulting in getting dressed before entering the rink for a minimum of 30 days. Cell phones are not allowed in the locker room, and it is the responsibility of the Association and coach to ensure that phones are secured outside the locker room. An Association will be fined

	\$500 for any Safe Sport violation taking place in a locker room without adequate or proper locker room supervision and the coach will be held accountable and subject to disciplinary action.

Pg. 30 Applying to All Age Divisions of Play No one may request that their player be placed on a higher class team. ***Language makes it sound like you cannot request to be placed on a higher class team within your age bracket, but you can request to play up an age level. For instance, if an "A" level player moves up to the next age bracket, could a "B" level player request to be moved up to take that player's spot on the "A" team? Does this need to be clarified?	This language is confusing/no longer needed/Update? Pg. 32 of Player Movement Consent Form states: It is the policy of MHC that each registered skater will play in his/her age level as set forth by USA Hockey rules. Returning skaters/goalies must initially register at the proper age level. However, there will be from time to time, requests for a player to play up an age level.

Pg. 35 Coaches are responsible for appropriate supervision of Club players, equipment and property before, during and after practices and games.	Add language re: pucks and puck buckets? Pucks are the responsibility of coaches/players and purchase of additional pucks will be their responsibility?
Pg. 39 Mosinee Papermakers 1. The Mosinee Papermakers are an amateur adult hockey team that registers with USA Hockey through the Mosinee Hockey Club, Inc. The Club facilitates this registration and provides for ice time for practices and games while the Papermakers or their supporting organizations provide for the rest of their needs.	Update Language to state that the Papermakers are a full-contact adult league that is part of the Great Lakes Hockey League and are governed by USA Hockey and WAHA?
Pg. 39 Advanced Play and Camp Grants 1. Mosinee Hockey Club will contribute \$100 per year toward expenses for each player from our Club making the Wisconsin Selects elite team. 2. Grants to Club members for other advanced play camps or teams may be requested from the Club.	What is the Wisconsin Selects Elite Team? Per Google, there are 2 teams that fit this description: Team Wisconsin (Boys 13O, 14U, 15O, 16U, and 18U) Wisconsin Selects (Girls U19) Are these 2 what the grants are for? Or does it include other travel/advanced teams outside Mosinee Hockey? Grants for play camps? Does this mean any summer camps that a player wants to attend could request a grant to help pay for these? Is the \$100 only for expenses attributed towards making the elite teams, and grants for camps are separate?
Pg. 40 Emergency Consent Form	Form is Online - do we need to keep this as part of the policy manual? Do coaches/team managers have access

	to this information in case of an emergency during a practice/game or do only the executive board have access? Can a copy of this information be kept in the office for emergency situations? le. I had to supervise a spring practice game when the coach canceled at the last minute. Besides myself, there were only 2 other adults in the rink, none of whom would have access to this information if one of the players got injured. In the future - should we require at least 1 parent/guardian to stay on site during practices/games in case of emergency? Obviously we don't want just anyone having access to this information.
