## 4. Level Updates - Feedback from coaches and parents at each level

- Modified Season went well for first year with the AAA, AA, and A format. Next year
  Travel teams will be picked before league teams. The new improvements to the upper
  field was very appreciated by this group to have their own field space.
- <u>Majors</u> mixed reviews with in house format with Hermantown. Will revisit quad cities
  participation next year. May look into dividing teams into AA and A next year depending
  on what others do.
- Rookies -Mixed reviews on this level. Concern for developing more pitching and
  increasing their baseball IQ. The in house format offers more practice time but the
  games take long as pitchers are still wild and hitters will wait for coaches to come in.
  Some ideas to increase development include: using a pitching machine for a few
  innings, more coach pitching, and Sunday pitching lessons. The main goal of this group

is to get as many defensive touches and at bats as possible. Will continue to evolve as the season gets closer.

- <u>Developmental</u> field space is always an issue for this level. It would be beneficial to be internal if we could secure field space. Also need to determine the right number of kids on each team.
- <u>Fun League</u> Jordan Walling willing to coordinate again. Positive feedback with the station style practices and utilizing the turf space.
