- <u>Developmental</u> no new updates . Schedule will be done by Cloquet and games will be at Braun Park and Chub Lake. There is some desire to see if we could implement our own in-house league at this level, however with field space we will not pursue that this year.

Other Topics: Sam is working on apparel through Advantage. We hope to have it live before registration opens. Kristin is willing to help Amy with sponsors again this year, Amy will follow up to finalize details.
