Privacy Policy

This Policy sets out how CAHA may collect and use any personal information which you provide.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

CAHA collects information provided by families at the time of registration and potentially other times. Additionally, CAHA compiles information regarding its teams throughout the season.

That information is generally of the following types, but may include other types as well:

- Address, phone number, emails of and for players and family members;
- Team member information;
- Messages you send to CAHA or in apps for the respective teams;
- Team information, such as rosters, schedules, attendance, statistics, and scores;
- Activity information you upload, including photos, news, information and other content;
- Payment information;
- Messages and feedback you send to CAHA; and
- Transactional information.

USE OF INFORMATION

Your information may be used by CAHA to:

- Provide services consistent with our association's purpose.
- For any specific purpose for which it was provided or volunteered.
- To send you information.
- To prevent fraud and defend legal rights.
- To comply with applicable law.

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

CAHA may share your information with:

- As required by law in with Law Enforcement Agencies or Regulators.
- Governing Bodies: CAHA may share your information with USA Hockey, Minnesota Hockey, or District 11 as required.

- Other requesting entities, with your permission.

VIOLATIONS OF POLICY

Violations of this policy will be addressed by the CAHA Board and may result in sanctions up to and including suspension or removal from the association, as deemed appropriate.
