 - Travel is all wrapped up for the season.
 - 1. Tryout dates are posted for next season
 - Coaches applications are posted
 - Lady Wild:
 - 1. Committed to the CGHL next season with 3 teams:
 - 8U
 - 10/12U All-star SILVER

- 12U GOLD (with a couple 13 year olds playing 1 age year down)
 - 2. Weekly ice for top team
 - 3. Will get in as a guest with the USGHL
 - Rec League is all wrapped up for the season.
 - 1. High energy in the rink with lots of excitement
 - 2. Banners for the winning teams.
 - Spring registration is finished.
 - 1. 151 players registered.
 - 2. 8U will have 30 kids across Mini and Mighty Mites. Will do 3 areas of cross-ice games. We're 10 off mark of last year (40 kids in 2025 Spring)
 - 3. Middle School league will have 4 teams with 12 players apiece (great turnout)
 - 4. All leagues filled up except High School league.
 - 5. Will not allow drop-ins for Spring League
 - We'll have skills sessions in the spring for kids. Kids are registering – not as fast as we anticipated.
 - 1. 24 kids in first session (8U/10U)
 - 2. 20 kids in second session (12+ group)
 - 3. Will allow drop-ins for skills
 - Could KAHA use some extra funds to do a summer camp? We could pay someone to do the camp, pay for the ice, and bill kids to participate. Could be a great use of funds.
 - Should we get more advertising with Olympics ongoing? We have Facebook but can we do more?
 - 1. Flyers at the school had a positive impact (drove ~10 skaters)
 - 2. Look at July to do more advertising to drive more skaters for Learn-2-Play and Learn-2-Skate
 - Tampering Investigation with Queen City. USA Hockey reached out to Tim Sinasac for 10-15 minutes to confirm what they're seeing in the file.
