Hockey Director Intro and Update:

Spring showcase update. Calls between clubs regarding head shots/concussions. Predatory head shots in future showcase games will warrant 5 min major and game misconduct (under ILWest). Was good for coaches to get a look at all players with four games.

Thinking about once-a-week skates to maintain conditioning. Suggestion of survey for parents/players. HD would be interested in running his own conditioning camp, if interest would support it. Mixing younger eighth graders with varsity kids gives good exposure.

Looking to schedule fall ice. Working with WBIA to evaluate days and times. Plan is to use all of allocated ice (main and studio rinks) under Club's agreement with WBIA.

Fall conditioning and tryouts. Discussed possibility of additional tryout fee that would ultimately be credited to fees for fall season. Discussion of JV2 team if enough skaters. Adding games to schedule; revenue considerations. Coaching compensation also implicated.

Discussed pros/cons of Battle Camp.

Coaches got a good look at kids during showcase but spring team projections will not be the same as the fall teams. Tryouts will determine what team a skater makes in the fall. August 19-20 for conditioning and Aug 22, 26 and 28 for tryouts. Season starts 9/2. IL West wants to start playing games 9/15. No AAA can be rostered.

Town hall format for information sessions prior to tryouts. Then parent meetings on team basis after teams selected for tryouts. Targeting August 16 for Town Hall meeting.

Pixellot v. WBIA video. Live Barn less expensive than Pixellot. WBIA video would allow for video teaching on bench on near real-time basis. Will not renew Pixellot.

North Central crossover concept. Would works as a season-long tournament. Only play 6 NC teams. Will positively impact ranking to play good teams. Play six teams before December then set up 1 v. 4, 2 v. 3 brackets. Benet, Fenwick and other clubs to round out the non-conference games/budget.

Summer 3:3 Update:

28 skaters/3 goalies. Three teams. Two games per week. One player will be communicator and will be responsible for communicating game times to teammates. Eleven 8th grade players are skating; remaining 21 a mix of V/JV players.
