- Audit
 - 5 total companies reached out to, 2 companies declined as our organization is too small, 2 additional companies connected with to develop scope of audit to establish a bid for service. Completion date TBD pending what the scope is and cost that will need to be provided to board. Will address the public once a firm has been chosen and a timeline developed.
- Have books been reconciled prior to providing to an auditor.
 - Yes, books were reconciled through 2024 and 2024 taxes have an extension filed for November 2025.
- Do we have a breakdown for cheer vs football, so we know what we are fundraising for?
 - Cheer expenses have been approved by president.
- What does the cheer registration go towards?
 - Insurance
 - \$6K for 2025
 - Field rentals for practice and games
 - \$15K-\$16K in 2024
 - o Community would like a full break down of all cheer costs
 - Coaches training \$1.5K to date
 - Homecoming costs
 - Cheer books
 - Admin fees
 - Cheer party and gifts \$3K
 - Backpack cost
 - Sky Valley and elite gymnastics cost break down provided by Cindy
 - Leverage documents provided as a guide to build a document for the public to see
 - Provide visual of cost for cheer vs football by athlete

- Cheer- athletes are upset that their friend that passed away from cancer was not recognized during the season.
 - Football players had yellow ribbons on their helmets all year, and a junior team had a moment of silence in remembrance of Rowen.
- For younger cheerleaders that are trying out of the older teams, will they be practicing with that team or with their age group?
 - Can the athlete focus and participate with the older groups, or do they require a parent to be present.
- Merch- Have an online store?
 - Lisa is building a store to be reviewed by the board to purchase prior to the season's start.
 - o 2 Week period to order. Open late July or August to order.
- A vendor will be selected that will allow customization and then be picked up by the team.
- Coaches should be involved in board member selection.
 - Board may not refill the newly vacated positions.
- Bylaw verbiage about how board members are selected during periords of term, resignation or removal.
- Fundraising
 - Request for \$250 upfront was too hard for Cindy to remain on board without the audit being completed to show transparency to the public.
 - The new board will provide better clarity to sponsors to outline what the money if going for.
