Financial Review

General Overview & Budget

- Jerrod Gould profit/loss comparisons for EOY budget review.
 - Net income was \$33k for 2025.
 - 28-30% increase in income from concessions.
- Accounts back up to ~\$75k.
- Jerrod Gould to come up with a budget for 2026.
 - Potentially some fixes to the fields.
 - Lights on Field 2 & 3.
- Jerrod Gould to investigate getting the tourism grant.
 - Ryan Talbert to help.

2025 & 2026 Raffle

- 2026 raffle has no updates or action items.
 - We don't need to print tickets until closer to season start.
- Jim Henaman made the tracking document and is currently raffling (2) of the 2025 remaining raffle items.

2026 Sponsors

- Brian Zell created a new folder in the 2026 year for sponsors.
 - He is working on documentation with prices the same.
 - He is making sure to emphasize the writing about turning in documentation by February 2nd, 2026.
- Brian Zell reached out to FSI printing for the banners.

2026 Attire

- Travel Attire
 - Quotes from Team (out of Marshfield).
 - Can do the Richardson hats a little cheaper.
 - Aleson apparel recommended (said it was better than Champro).
 - It's basically the same as Champro from AE for cost.
 - Brad Menning was thinking of doing Aleson due to expected quality benefit and website design is better.
 - 5-day lead times.
 - Brad Menning to propose a finalized plan and move forward with ordering next meeting.
- City Attire
 - Team also quoted for City league and were quite a bit more expensive.
 - They can do hats \$0.50 cheaper and fully embroidered.
 - It would be tougher to get extras in a small quantity quickly.
 - The board agrees for Brad Menning to pursue the fully embroidered hats through Team.
 - Brad Menning is planning to use AE for City jerseys again.
 - Same type of shirt as last year (the better kind).

- Resto Athletic
 - Samples were given to Brad Menning for review.
 - ~\$45 for pants and jersey combination.
- Spectator Apparel
 - Brad Menning to use Team for online spectator apparel store.
 - Could potentially add team attire and have parents purchase extra jerseys, pants, etc.
 - \$58 for Champro team bag with embroidered customization.

2026 Travel League Registration

- 10U recruiting efforts
