Coach Dyson is starting his seventh year as the Hockey Director and Varsity Head Coach for Huskies Hockey.

Dyson has been coaching high school hockey in Illinois for 14 years with a successful track record of program building and player development. He was named the Illinois High School West Division Coach of the Year in 2012-13, 2016-17, and 2017-2018. In addition he received the Illinois West President's Award for Program Building in 2015-16 for his work at Oak Park and received the Lori Maly Distinguished Service to The Game Award in 2010.

Coach Dyson was also the coach of the Team Illinois America's showcase team 2014-2016, where the team won twice and finished second once.

"Coaching hockey at this level is about more than developing better hockey players," he said. "It's about developing better people. Over 80-percent of our kids were on the honor roll last year and we'll continue to have a standard of a strong commitment to academics and community service during the upcoming season."

Coach Meagher is in his seventh year as Varsity Coach. Steve has been involved with hockey as either a player or coach for over 30 years. A native of Binghamton, New York, Steve grew up playing in NY's Southern Tier Hockey Association and went on to play 4 years of ACHA hockey at West Virginia University. Coach Meagher spent the last 5 years as the Assistant Varsity Coach for the Bartlett Wildhawks Hockey Program, where he helped numerous players to achieve All-State and Showcase honors while also helping to lead the Wildhawks to the Combined Division's Blackhawk Cup State Championship Game in 2012 and the semi-finals in 2013.

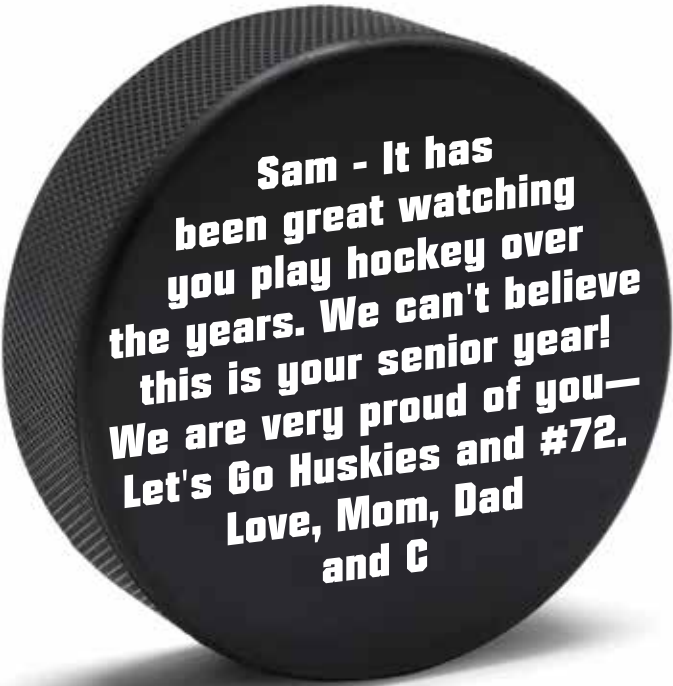
