Your family's privacy is important to SALA. To protect your family's privacy this notice to explain online information practices and the choices your family can make about the way SALA collects and uses your information.

What We Collect

This notice applies to all information collected or submitted on the association's website or season management platform. You may have the opportunity to submit personal information, including:

- Name
- Address
- Email address
- Phone Number
- Birthdate

How Your Information is Used

SALA uses the information you provide only in the context of your family's involvement with SALA. SALA uses the information to the extent necessary to complete your order or respond to your request. SALA does not share your family's information unless necessary for management of operations. Our website is the primary communication tool with our members. Team managers, coaches, and authorized personnel are the only individuals permitted access to information and pictures about participants, teams, activities, games and tournament results. Any content SALA's board deems to be offensive, demeaning or derogatory will be removed and the offending party's access will be suspended. Please notify SALA at info@stillwaterlacrosse.com if you believe any information falls into that category.

Email Use

Email addresses will not be shared with any parties without your explicit consent during registration due to federal guidance of email addresses as personally identifiable information, unless SALA is required to produce the information by state or federal law. If you would like your email address removed from the SALA list you can unsubscribe from receiving system generated emails from SportEngine by unsubscribing in your SE account. Removal of your email address will prevent your receipt of club information.

SALA's Commitment to Children's Privacy

Protecting the privacy of children is especially important. SALA's database is secure, with the necessary safeguards in place to prevent unauthorized use. To assist in maintaining children's privacy, SALA will publish photographs without identifying any child by name on its website or official social media accounts. SALA may publish stories about teams' accomplishments.

Your child's name will appear on the team roster on SALA's website. Team pages are public, but if you do not want your child's picture to accompany his name on the roster you have the right to tell the team manager and coach that no picture should accompany your child's name on the team roster on SALA's website.

The association has two official social media accounts: Facebook and Instagram. Teams may have individual Twitter accounts, Instagram accounts, and private Facebook groups which are not endorsed by SALA.

By authorizing the use of your child's name, you agree to release any claims against SALA, including, without limitation, any SALA board member for any injury or damage arising out of or related to publishing your child's name on the SALA website, the SALA official Facebook page or Instagram account.

Please note, during a lacrosse season the name or other information relating to your lacrosse player may be published in various tournament books or directories or in Publications, and SALA does not have any control over the dissemination of such personal information of your lacrosse player.
