- **Futures Program was planned to expand to have 11u -14u teams, but shortly after this meeting Minnesota hockey put a pause on the program.

- D10 has asked us to pay the referee invoice ASAP once we receive it,
- Tier 1 tryouts have been moved up to June this year
- May 1-3 is the annual Minnesota Hockey leadership conference
 - The location was not noted, but has historically been held at the St Louis Park Marriott
- **PCA leadership workshop was held on January 8th. Attendance was great! We had 116 kids show up of the 120 that signed up, most if not all of the kids that didn't show were due to illness. The kids participated more than any of the parents or coaches did during their workshop.
 - Just this morning I received an email from Amy Manson the Sr program manager for the PCA, and another from the Vice president of the PCA Jeff Dale, asking if I would be able to attend their next board meeting to speak on our partnership with the PCA and the workshops we have held. We are one of only a couple of groups who have held workshops for parents, coaches, and players. Members of the Vikings, Wild, FC united, and Twins will all be be represented there as well
 - please submit any feedback you have -positive or negative- to me via email as I have already started a working list
- **All remaining Sportsengine balances have now been sent to collections. At last check, that amount was down to about \$18,000.
- Multiple issues have come in from D10 regarding rosters, redlines, fines, and arbitrary rules that seem to be getting made up, so a good portion of my time has been trying to work with the district to clean up these items. Still waiting for an appeal decision on another sibling that wanted to sign up for little Elks.
- **This year has proven to be the worst I can recall as far as game misconducts, suspensions, and match penalties that have been given to our players/coaches. I don't have the district wide stats as of now, but will be working to get them from D10 to see if this is the case across the entire district or if we are just having a really bad year in Elk River. One of our teams currently has 215 penalty minutes in 21 league games, which is an average of 10 minutes per game. The next closest team in that division has 106.

- The roof continues to leak in the fieldhouse and into the dryland area. Ben Jaremko reported that he had 8 buckets set up last week, and they were filling up in less than an hour. Katie had a roof company out and is hopeful they can repair the roof in the spring/summer, but nothing can be done until then
- I have been in communication with the President of Grand Rapids Youth Hockey regarding their pavilion rink, which opened last season. The project was initiated in 2016 with the construction of the pavilion structure at an approximate cost of \$1 million. In 2024, the organization approved the addition of coolant lines and a chiller system. This required removal and replacement of the existing concrete; however, the refrigeration portion of the project was completed for approximately \$1.6 million, bringing the total investment to roughly \$2.6 million. This may be a more cost-effective alternative to constructing a 3rd indoor sheet of ice in Elk River. Pursuing a similar option would likely require collaboration and support from both the City and the School District.
- I am hearing multiple complaints about the lack of ice this season. For those of you that were on the board a couple of years ago, I predicted if we continued to grow at the rate we were we would be out of ice in 2-4 years, and here we are.
 - ERYHA player enrollment
 - The registration data is no longer available on Sportsengine but I did look it up last year when we still had access, in 2018 when I started as president our total player enrollment was in the 400's (I don't have the exact number), this season we are at 705. A third sheet of ice OR supplemental ice will need to be priority number 1 for the association moving forward.

- **Consistent brand feel** - Maintain a recognizable tone, visual style, and messaging so all content feels like Elk River Youth Hockey - regardless of which team it comes from.
- **Social style/How-to guides** - On my to-do list for this year is to create a simple one-page guide for the board outlining social media best practices, including pros and cons, key things to know, and when and how to retag, reshare, and amplify content. . In addition, I want to create a “light suggestion” social style guide for teams that run their own accounts - not as a requirement, but as a resource to help align with the overall brand look, messaging, and content approach. The intent is to make collaboration easier, encourage consistent storytelling, and help all teams elevate our hockey while maximizing reach across platforms.

Bottom Line + Takeaway
