Parent/Coach Checklist to Complete Before Return to Play ☐ Sit the player out if a concussion is suspected. If symptoms persist and they do not return to the game put the player in concussion protocol. ☐ Player must be evaluated by healthcare provider with experience in pediatric concussion management. Polar Caps will reimburse family for evaluation if financial assistance is needed. ☐ The player will now be in Concussion protocol and to start the necessary steps with WAHA and the Polar Caps Complete the attached form https://form.jotform.com/200587181766058 and send a note to Dr. Laura Mendyk via email to llmendyk@gmail.com. Once player has been evaluated, send written clearance notice from health care provider to Dr. Laura Mendyk via email to Ilmendyk@gmail.com. ☐ When the player has been cleared to play the attached form needs to be signed by the parent, coach, and healthcare provider. The letter clearing the player to play from the healthcare provider can be used in place of a signature.
