Budget/Financials [Treasurer]

Patrick Quinlan provided a budgeting overview and issues for consideration for 2021-2022 season: Key points:

- Approximately \$40K in Savings and \$63K in Checking
- Run a zero based non-profit budget
- Average cost of outdoor rink is approximately \$47K which provides usually one extra touch a
 week but significant impact to skater cost.
- **FUTURE ACTION**: determine whether or not outdoor rink should be run this year and how we handle uniform expense
- FUTURE ACTION: create more transparency in what is included in fees and how it compares to other comparable clubs

Recruiting Actions [Recruitment Chair]

Matt Mialik provided an update on the recruitment committee. Key points:

- Provided marketing pamphlet on back of Learn to Skate exit paperwork
- Provided social media posts for Learn to Play program
- Working with Little Blackhawks to move program to the fall to encourage better flow into the program
- Requested that people with photos reach out to Matt for use on website and social media
