- 2) approval of minutes

- 3) President News Leek in Roof at MIA and leaked to power box causing blow fuses. Ice was down for three days and lost time for High School tournament. Roof and power box fixed and MIA filing an insurance claim for damages and lost ice fees.
- -Ice will be out at MIA in August. Both the studio and main sheet will be redone with brand new logos on the main sheet
- Meeting with UW Asst Matt Walsh in July, along with other Region 4 reps. UW is trying to get back to working with local clubs to increase interest in UW Hockey and attendance at games. Rich talked about what UW used to do many years ago to increase interest in the Bob Johnson era.
- Discussed the preliminary numbers for competitive teams and needing good numbers to help out with fees. Possible 3-4 PW teams and 2-3 Bantam level.
- Discussed a concern from parent on females in locker rooms. Parent with female player will be a first year PW and concerned she wouldn't be able to be allowed in locker room. Rich talked about the past concerns but concluded it was more to do with a female asst. coach and parent rather than the player. Concluded we will allow the player to dress until further notice.
- Transfers Several rumors have risen lately. Coach for Polar Caps was contacted by two parents and contacted region 4 regarding the procedure for transfers. Jerry Kennedy (WAHA) contacted Jeff Barfield to explain that we need to be careful about transfers. Clubs have been sanctioned for recruiting and didn't want us to be affected. All communication to Region 4 should come from Jeff Barfield in the futures. Board discussed if we even need transfers at the Pee Wee level to displace current current PC players. Agreed to do nothing until players receive release or register.
