



## KLA Board Meeting Minutes

### Tuesday, October 7, 2025

Meeting was called to order at 6:40 pm at 8309 Whitley Rd., Ste 101, Keller. Board members present: Mike, Julie, Justin, Amy, Kenneth, Colin, Matt A, Matt T and Daniel via Zoom/Teams.

- I. September minutes were emailed to all board members. There were no questions or concerns. No edits or changes needed.

**Motion was made to accept the September meeting minutes. Motion seconded; all approved. None opposed.**

- II. Financial Report – Spreadsheet given to all members. Balance is showing higher than budgeted due to youth and bantam registration full year vs fall only. Upcoming outgoing costs will be Lax for Life tourney (4 teams), and deposit for uniforms. Helmet orders: have 3 adult and 6 youth left.

#### III. Fundraising

- a. Telethon on 9/30 has brought in \$27,507 so far. Link is live until 10/24/2025. Will plan to post on social media. Some different thoughts on doing it again next year included being able to do ourselves, is credit card service negotiable, Kenneth has a lead on a different company, etc.
- b. Spirit night at Jason's Deli resulted in \$159.75 to KLA. Check has been mailed.
- c. Next spirit night scheduled for 10/8 at Freddy's.
- d. First sponsor banner has been received and hung on fence at KSP. Cost was \$385. Matt sent pictures via email; looks good. Will order others. Discussed location to hang on fence and city possibly not ok with where we choose.

#### IV. Age Director Update

- a. Bantam –3/4 had sixies scrimmage against Southlake. Kids got burned out quickly. Mike is thinking to hold bantam practice over spring break. On 10/26 Prosper is having a playday as a fundraiser for NICU. Bantam invited to participate.
- b. Youth – 7/8 had sixies scrimmage against Southlake. Lots of running. Youth planning to participate in the Prosper playday and Lax for Life. Noted Tuesdays during fall is not a good day for youth to hold practice as most middle school football games are on Tuesdays. Proposed switching with bantam to a different day. Coaches will discuss with Justin. Aggieland for youth up in the air. Issues are available coaches and cold temps for practices leading up to tourney.
- c. HS – Will have a JV and V team entered in Aggieland. Need to send Kenneth list of tasks for game day.

V. New Business

- a. DFWLL meeting on 10/2 – Matt T and Mike attended. Highlights:
  - i. Formalized an agreement with the refs. Depending on time a game gets cancelled; refs may still get paid.
  - ii. Youth games are officially 12-minute running clock.
  - iii. Bantam games to be scheduled on the hour. Youth games to be scheduled for 90 minutes.
  - iv. Bantam back to having faceoffs.
  - v. Rosters must be in by 2/1/2026. Agreed to open our Spring registration at tail end of Fall or immediately following end of Fall.
- b. Raised awareness to spam emails coming from Chris. Reminded all to not respond and text Chris if not sure.

VI. Open Discussion

1. Received an email (girls lacrosse also copied) from KHS regarding Homecoming parade stating a community member reported the lacrosse float throwing too hard and hitting a child causing a cut. Per principal Lisa Simmons, lacrosse is not allowed to throw anything from their float next year. Coach Anderson spoke with the team at practice today. Also discussed the younger group and needing a different strategy with either more adults to help or having HS kids walk and younger kids on the float. Will need to table until next year.
2. City of Keller – Daniel and Justin met with Cody from Parks and Rec regarding:
  - a. Decided to grandfather KLA regarding resident and non-resident fee increases until next year. For 2025, fees are \$0/\$30. Will owe new fee (\$10/\$50) in December of 2026.
  - b. Agreed to predetermined block time for grass fields.
  - c. Regarding turf field – soccer has priority; however, they won't submit their requested time until late January. City will allow us to submit our requests, but KLA needs to be flexible once we know soccer's schedule.
