- ✓ I will not use social media as a platform to comment or to spark confrontational behavior or engage in public disputes that could negatively impact the team.
- ✓ I agree to respect the privacy of players, coaches, and other parents. I will not share sensitive or personal information without consent.
- ✓ I will communicate my concerns through the proper channels and in a dignified manner.
- ✓ I will not undermine the coaches' instructions or directions.
- ✓ I will not use profanity!
- ✓ I will stay informed about the program's schedule, rules, and guidelines. I will ensure my child is punctual and prepared for practices and games.
- ✓ I will set an example of commitment to ensure my child attends practices and games regularly and arrives on time. I understand that my commitment is just as important as my child's for the team's progress and success.

By adhering to this code of conduct, I acknowledge my role as a positive influence in my child's football experience and my commitment to fostering a respectful and supportive community. I understand that any violation of this code may result in disciplinary actions such as being barred from all future functions or suspension of my child from participating as determined by the program administrators.
