



Josh Robinson, a native of Spokane, Washington, has made San Diego home since 2012. Prior to moving to San Diego, Josh played junior hockey for the Great Falls Americans in the America West Hockey League (2001-02), and then played NCAA for four years at Salem State University (Salem, MA) from 2002-06. Robinson graduated with a degree in Sport Management, and from there was an assistant coach at Bentley University (D-I, Atlantic Hockey Association, 2007-08), two years as assistant coach at Colby College (D-III, NESCAC, 2008-09, 2009-10) and as an assistant coach at University of Connecticut (D-I, Atlantic Hockey Association, 2010-11).

After coaching collegiately for four seasons, Robinson went back to school and received his Master's in Education from University of San Diego, where he has been working as a middle school special education teacher since 2015. Robinson became involved with coaching again with the San Diego Saints AA and AAA teams for the next five seasons.
