

Goalie and Family Discount Policy

As a nonprofit youth hockey organization, we strive to make youth hockey affordable. We would like to offer financial assistance while ensuring fairness and sustainability for families. We do this by working hard to secure season sponsors and by holding numerous fundraising events.

Goalie Discount Eligibility

A goalie discount is available to players who commit to serving as a full-time goaltender for the organization throughout the season at the Squirt, PeeWee, Bantam, and Midget levels. This discount is not applicable to players enrolled in Learn to Skate/Learn to Play, Mites, or the Girls Lightning supplemental program.

Eligibility Considerations- The discount may be reviewed or adjusted if a player:

- Does not possess their own goaltending gear.
- Experiences challenges with consistent commitment or attendance at scheduled practices and games.
- Participates as a dual-rostered player in a way that creates scheduling conflicts affecting goalie availability for Berkshire Youth Hockey games.
- The organization reserves the right to determine whether a player meets the requirements of a full-time goalie.

Combining Discounts

- Families may not combine a goalie discount with a sibling discount for or within the same family.

Multiple Goalie Discounts

- Families with more than one child serving as a full-time goalie may receive goalie discounts for each eligible goalie.

Sibling Discount Eligibility

- The sibling discount applies only to players registered on travel teams.
- Families with three or more siblings participating on eligible travel teams will receive a \$100 discount per sibling after the 2nd registration.
- Players registered in **Learn to Skate (LTS)**, **Learn to Play (LTP)**, and the supplemental, Girls **Berkshire Lightning** programs are not eligible for the sibling discount and are excluded from the sibling discount calculation.

Failure to Fulfill Goalie Commitment

- If a player receives a goalie discount and later chooses not to fulfill their commitment as a full-time goalie, the family will be responsible for repaying the discounted portion of the registration fees.
- The balance owed must be paid in full within a timeframe established by the organization.
