Review/Approve Minutes from last meeting: – Nofsinger 1st, King 2nd, all in favor-approved

- 1.** Treasurer's Report: Report emailed by Kristi Roush. Nofsinger 1st, Haun 2nd, all in favor-approved.
- 2.** Facilities: 1) Ice out dates planned for the week of 5/16-5/20. Blue Devils last day needed is 5/12. 2) Rebuilt Zamboni motor on hand and invoiced \$520. Replacement in case needed as current was replaced by warranty. 3) Potential of installing ceiling fans in Zamboni room discussed. Will continue discussion.
- 3.** WAHA & Director of Hockey: State tournaments will be starting this weekend. State tourney fees and play down payments have been made by TYH. Invoices will be sent to Sparta and Black River Falls program for their portion. Bantam/Pee Wee teams are split between Tomah and Sparta, U12 team is split between Tomah, Sparta, and Black River Falls, U14 team is split between Tomah and Black River Falls.
- 4.** Equipment: 1) Cross ice turn in 03/10. 2) All Titan jerseys must be turned into Luke Haun at completion of season. This is the responsibility of each team's head coach. 3) Those not returning TYH issued equipment will be invoiced for payment.
- 5.** Concessions: 1) Cross ice jamboree had great weekend with approximately \$6000 revenue. 2) Concessions winding down for the year with one open skate, WEHL facility use, and 3 on 3 tournament to finish the year. 3) Pizza oven donation by On Wisconsin
- 6.** Fund Raising: Tractor Pull assoc. requesting advertisement fee trade for use of the cooler they purchased years ago. Advertisement invoices to continue as TYH has paid to fix and maintain cooler.
- 7.** Tournament / Scheduler: Nothing to report

- 9.** Long range Planning / Recruitment: Nothing to report
- 10.** TNT: 3 on 3 tournament almost full. TNT alumni wall proposed. Supported by board with next steps identifying best location and format for this and former college players currently displayed at rink. Further discussion needed.
