I would also like to take an opportunity to recognize the PW AA team for rolling with a rotating goalie situation, and the parents that helped coordinate. I am proud of the way the CPYHA community and PW AA team stood up and showed their support for Max and his family.

	4 Coaching knowledge share - what kind of vehicles do we have to help each other out? End of season summaries? In season summit?  5 Update to policy and procedures as part of CPYHA handbook that relate to traveling committee and its components.
