There were 16 baskets (3 less than 2023) with a total of \$3425 raised (YoY difference of (\$2080)). Raffle items donated included: Wooden Hockey Stands(Amy Jackson's dad), Kern and MN Lakers Camps, Jersey Quilts, Dibs, Sherwin Williams Paint Kit. Tickets were sold @ \$5 each, raising a total of \$940 (YoY difference of (\$605)) *Note to begin raffle on Friday at the start of Jamboree Games 2024 Vendors- Two Scoops sold ice cream all weekend (pending # bowls sold)They said it was worth their while. OhFerCute Face Painting was there Saturday 1-8pm. (pending final sales from vendor). Champlin Athletic all three days, Free Mullet cuts during coaches game 144 shirts sold (YoY increase of 13 shirts) Each Mite team had a party. Parties included cupcakes, Gatorade, medals, Hockey accessory Bag swag \$100.00 (Savings by using previous year supplies) Coaches Game featured competition at 2nd intermission(Fastest Skater and Best Celly) which is always a hit. During the coaches game, 94/144 Mites registered. Any mite in attendance we held a MITE ONLY Raffle, CHUCK A PUCK and Parent Appreciation Raffle Free mullets were given during the coaches game only by Sports Clips.
	 NEW THIS YEAR: Two 24/25 DIBS hours for Raffle and Silent Auction Basket. Made the decision to only do bag tags on odd jamboree years. Still was able to provide a personalized gift for players with last name hockey accessory bags Two Scoops was a hit. Mites got a free coupon and it was worth their while in sales. OhFerCute FacePainting was also a huge hit for CPCR and CP Rebel Players Made a strategic decision to balance CP Rebels with CPCR girls teams to ensure they felt included in the Mite Jamboree(decor, personalization, team parties) Secured \$1150.00 in jamboree specific sponsors Outside teams received snack bags of candy/juice. *Leveraging 2023 supply overage Silent Auction was setup in the PIT. This worked great! Had credit card machine set up with Don and Kelly for silent auction payment
