	Raffle (Kristi) – 1/19 7:00 pm. Drawing 42 names for prizes. Will post by Thursday. Kristi issued 276 packes, 48 not eligible (buy out, board, late registration). Of 276 issues, 13 had to be pulled out (we decided not to have them do the raffle, approved, etc). 263 total participants, one of these was a mite player who has not paid, they did not respond. These were paid for from the general fund.
	Had 97% return rate on raffles to collect at her home. Found this was much better than doing at the forum. 7 players of the 263 that did not return to managers. Suggestions are welcome on process changes.
	Pizza (Julie) - 1600 pizza sales, down quite a bit. Everything set up for next Tuesday, 1/25/2022. Bantam AA helping (HS had a game). Shortened the pick up time. They collected everyone's name and number when they took orders so they can call people if needed. Most people come early.
Candy Bars – Abby Pizza – Kari Wreaths – Jess	Proposing no Heggies next year. Luigis. They can mix with other stuff like butterbraid or cookies. It's all onine, no check collecting. They box all of the sales for the player are all boxed together. Percent for profit is very similar. They cut the check to us.

	<ol> <li>How long we hold on to checks is a long time, ~1.5-2 months. Could go to a venmo option. Jennifer Erickson (does the accounting), she said it would just be a matter of tracking it. Wells Fargo prefers us to use Zelle. Have one longer turn in night. One volunteer monitors computer and phone for orders, venmo, etc. Venmo – is charging if over \$600 fees as of this year. Could use sportsngine, there is fee for that too, could add a transacton fee.</li> <li>Customer pool is shrinking because so many people they know are in hockey selling too. Could we offer this to mite parents? They may not have a traveling connection, yet. They could get half the proceeds, the other half go to all traveling players. Could be used to pay for \$100 advanced players, cut checks, or Champlin Athletic gift cards. Could even be used to go into an account for future when traveling, and if not used, it is lost.</li> <li>The wreath committee move to co-coordinators. Add Jennifer Erickson and Faith Fehrman, for three person team. Do away with the committee, and just do other volunteers.</li> </ol>
