



## **Munising Hockey Season Information**

Welcome Back, here is our information for the Munising Hockey for the 2026–2027 season! Our goal is to provide a fun, competitive, and positive hockey experience for players and families of all ages and skill levels.

Please review the registration requirements, fee schedule, payment options, volunteer expectations, and available discounts carefully before completing registration. Registration is completed online through Crossbar and requires a current USA Hockey registration number prior to signing up.

Munising Hockey is a volunteer-driven organization, and family participation through fundraising and volunteer support helps keep our programs successful and affordable for all players.

### **2026–2027 Registration Fees**

### **Additional Costs**

Registration with the Munising Hockey Association includes Districts, Regionals, and one tournament for 10U/12U/14U players (if applicable), and two tournaments for the Superior Icebreakers 12U Girls Tier III team (if applicable). The 8U team will be registered for 2-3 Jamborees for the Season.

Players who are not registered with the Munising Hockey Association may be responsible for additional tournament fees.

Additional expenses may include:

- Team apparel
- Team events
- Additional Tournaments (All Teams)
- State Tournament fees (if a team qualifies)
- Travel, lodging, and meals for away games and tournaments
- 8U Jamboree Baskets

Travel expenses are the responsibility of each family and are not included in registration fees.

### **Registration Checklist**

Please complete the following steps before registering your player for the upcoming season:

- Register your player with **USA Hockey** and obtain a current **USA Hockey Confirmation Number**.
- Create a **Crossbar** account (Parent/Guardian) if you do not already have one.
- Visit [munisinghockey.org](http://munisinghockey.org) and select the **Registration** tab to complete your player's registration.
- Complete all required registration forms and acknowledgments.
- Select your preferred payment option and ensure registration fees are paid according to the payment schedule chosen during registration.
- Review the Volunteer and Fundraising Requirements prior to completing registration.

## **Payment Options**

All registration fees are collected online through Crossbar at the time of registration. A \$150 down payment is required to complete registration.

## **Pay In Full**

Families may pay their balance in full online. Registration fees must be paid before a player may participate in practices or team activities.

## **Payment Plan**

Families may choose a 5-month automatic payment plan through Crossbar. Payments will automatically process on the 1st of each month using the credit or debit card saved to the account.

## **Available Discounts**

May only combine up to one (1) of the following discounts:

1. Coach Discount: \$100 off
2. Board Member Discount: \$100 off

Eligible discounts are limited to one per household and will be applied as a credit to the oldest registered child. Please note that discounts do not apply to the Learn to Skate program.

## **Scholarship Opportunities**

Scholarships may be awarded on a case-by-case basis. Applications must be submitted to the Munising Hockey Board for review and eligibility determination.

## **Equipment Information**

We do have you sign a checkout of all equipment and expect it to be returned at the end of the season.

- **Learn-to-Skate & 8U:** Equipment including pads, helmet, stick, and skates will be provided by Munising Hockey.

- **8U & 10U:** If available, pads, helmet, stick and skates are provided by the Munising Hockey Association.
- **12U & 14U:** Families are expected to provide player equipment. Limited equipment room inventory may be available for seasonal use, but availability is not guaranteed.

Families are responsible for the care and timely return of all loaned equipment. Equipment that is lost, damaged beyond normal wear and tear, or not returned may result in the family being held financially responsible for the replacement cost of the missing equipment.

## Volunteer & Fundraising Requirements

Munising Hockey is a volunteer-run organization. Every family plays an important role in helping make our season successful.

### Volunteer Hours

- **20 volunteer hours** are required per family each season.
- **Learn-to-Skate families** are required to complete **10 volunteer hours**.

Volunteer opportunities may include:

- Concessions
- Tournaments
- Scorekeeping
- Fundraising events
- Special events
- Other Association activities as needed

All families are also expected to participate in Association fundraising activities, including:

- Wreath Fundraiser
- Pizza Kit Fundraiser
- Raffle Ticket Fundraiser

Families with players on teams hosting a home tournament may be assigned a minimum of **two (2) volunteer hours** during the tournament by the Tournament Director or Tournament Committee.

## Volunteer Buyout Option

Each family must choose **one** of the following during registration:

- **Volunteer Buyout** - Pay a one-time \$250 Volunteer Buyout Fee during registration to satisfy your volunteer and fundraising requirement for the season.
- **Volunteer Commitment** - Choose to complete the required volunteer hours and fundraising activities during the season. Families selecting this option will not pay the buyout during registration. However, if volunteer and fundraising requirements are not completed by the end of the season, a one-time \$250 Volunteer/Fundraising Deposit will be charged on **March 1** to the registration account of the family's oldest registered child.

## Additional Information

- The \$250 charge is applied once per family, regardless of the number of registered players.
- Any duplicate charges will be refunded.
- Learn-to-Skate families who complete their required volunteer commitment will receive a \$100 registration refund and will not be charged the \$250 Volunteer/Fundraising Deposit.
