



SHOOTING ROOM FAQ

Location: Far end of rink 2

Sessions Facilitated by: Scheduled team's coaching staff

Required Equipment: Helmet, stick, gloves, athletic attire & tennis shoes

This space is only to be used when scheduled by the ice scheduler

- Sessions are assigned as close to practice times as possible, and on the same day in hopes of one less trip to the rink for coaches & families.
- There may be up to an hour gap before or after a practice.
- With two ice sheets, there could be 8 eligible teams to put in that 1 hour. The ice sheets also have different start times which also makes matching directly to a team difficult at times.
- There are also teams that simply did not work out to assign the shooting room time on the same day as a practice and a few were assigned a time on a non-practice time and date given all the above variables.
- No teams are assigned times on game days. If any were overlooked, please email the ice scheduler to let him know; team, date & time
- If a team does not want/need their assigned time or would like to add a date for the shooting room simply have the Team Manager email the ice scheduler with the team, date, and time and he will cancel and/or find a time for you.
- What do I do with time in between?
 - Do chalk talk in the bleachers or an area away from rink traffic
 - Visit the concession stand
 - Tape your sticks, tighten the helmet screws, sharpen skates
 - Cheer on another Shakopee team who is playing
 - Reserve the meeting room to watch game film
- Question -There is not enough room in that area for all 13 players to be shooting. Solution: 1/2 the players shoot for 25 min and the other half do dryland in the corner of Rink 2 or outside. Then switch. Take the last 10 to 15 min to work on individuals needing more time or to sharpen a skill.
- Should I pick up the pucks when I'm done? ABSOLUTELY – just like your team should leave the locker room better than you found it.
- No food, guns, or drinks allowed in the shooting room
- No skates
- Shoot against tarp only
- Red pucks are for the shooting room ONLY and must remain in the room

As a team you should be respectful to the rink, its equipment, staff, other teams and the guests of the rink at all times. Be ready to hit the ice with a great shot!
