



## Replacement Goalie Policy for Region and State Tournaments

### Policy:

In the event none of a team's normally rostered goalies are available for a Region or State Tournament, a replacement goalie may be obtained by this process:

- The replacement goalie may be chosen from the same or a lower classification, but not higher playing division as defined in Youth Playing Rules Section VII. Levels of Play A & B.
- The replacement goalie is acquired first from within the local association, second from teams within the District, and finally from the vicinity in which the tournament is being played.
- The replacement goalie must wear the jersey from his/her home team
- The replacement goalie must abide by the player rest rules as stated in Youth Rules, Section VIII, Paragraph J.
- The replacement goalie may NOT play if a normally rostered goalie becomes able to play.
- Must have the approval of the District Director (Both Directors if more than one District is involved) on the Spare Goalie form.

Note: Regional and State Tournament play are covered under Youth Rules, Section VI, Paragraph. C
