Avalanche in the Dells U6 Jamboree

Player Eligibility

This event is designed for 6U players. Younger skaters may participate if their coach determines they can do so safely. All activities follow USA Hockey's recommendations for the 6U Mite level.

Arrival & Game Preparation

- A check-in table will be available on Saturday morning beginning 30 minutes before the first scheduled game.
- Teams should be dressed and ready to take the ice 15 minutes before their assigned start time.
- Warmups begin at the listed game time.
- Home/away designations and jersey colors are provided on the schedule.

Game Format & Timing

Each game runs within a 40-minute block:

- **Warmup:** 4 minutes
- **1st Period:** 15 minutes (running clock)
- **Intermission:** 90 seconds
- **2nd Period:** 15 minutes (running clock)
- **Post-game handshake & exit:** 4.5 minutes
- **Line changes:** Every 1 minute 30 seconds via buzzer

Gameplay Rules

- Games are played on one-third of the ice surface with no goalies.
- Teams will skate either 3-on-3 or 4-on-4. Coaches should agree on the number before the game; if they cannot, the default is 3-on-3.
- Each period begins with a faceoff. After that, play continues without stoppages.
- When a goal is scored:
 - The scoring team must skate back and touch their own net.
 - The team scored upon retrieves a new puck from behind their net.
- During line changes, on-ice coaches will pick up the puck and toss it to a neutral area to reset play.
- If a player must double-shift, they must tag their bench during the change before re-entering play.

Equipment Requirements

Neck guards are mandatory for all players. Anyone without one will not be permitted to participate.

Locker Rooms

Assignments for each game will be posted on the whiteboard in the lobby.

On-Ice Coaches & Officials

- Each team may have one coach on the ice, and all coaches must wear helmets.
- No USA Hockey officials will be used for these games.

Conduct Expectations

Monroe Youth Hockey maintains a strict zero-tolerance policy.

Any behavior—by players, coaches, parents, or spectators—that compromises safety, respect, or the spirit of youth hockey will be addressed immediately. Written reports will be required for any complaints. The Tournament Director may remove individuals from games or the facility for actions such as:

- Fighting or encouraging fights
- Abusive or obscene language
- Intimidation or harassment
- Ignoring instructions from rink staff or tournament officials
