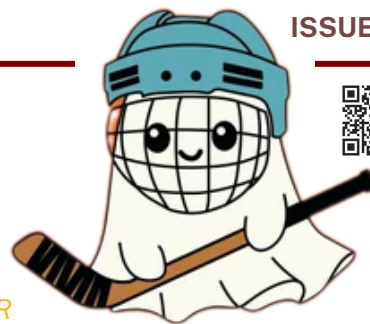

NEW MITES PLUS TRAINING PROGRAM!

FLHA is now offering a Mites Plus training program designed for Mite/8U Level 3 & 4 players in 3rd grade. The program will be focused on skating skill development and led by a professional skating coach. The program costs \$295 per skater. Sessions will be 1 hour a week from 10/14/24 to 2/21/25. GIRLS HOCKEY NIGHT AT THE RINK WAS *Sweet!*

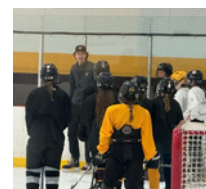
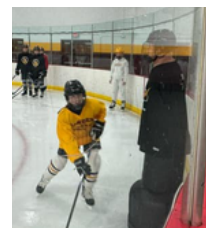
