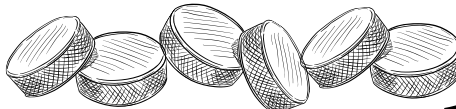


## welcome

## MONTHLY FAQs

Each month we received a number of great questions. To share the information broadly, we've introduced "Monthly FAQs!"

**Q: My volunteer requirement is 2 hours, why does my account say 14 hours?**

**A:** Due to a system limitation, all players are set at the same number of volunteer hours (14). If your requirement is less, you will receive a credit in the system in the coming 1-2 months.

**Q: I have 2 kids playing this season. Do I need to register for the Volunteer Hours Program twice?**

**A:** Yes, each player need to be registered to receive tryout jerseys.

**Q: Why do I not have access to view DIBs opportunities?**

**A:** To view and sign up for DIBs, your player must first be registered for the Volunteer Program.

## NEWS FROM THE CONCESSION STAND

The concession stand will open for the Mallards Sept 7 and Sept 20 games, and it will open for the season on Friday, October 4th.

### Concession Stand Shift Reminders:

- You must be 17yo+ to work a shift.
- Extra people are NOT allowed in the stand.
- Long hair (*male and female*) must be up.
- A hat or baseball cap must be worn.
- Sign the sheet between the cash registers to receive credit for your shift.
- Disposable gloves are available and must be worn whenever working with non pre-packaged food.
- If you would like a training, please show up 15 minutes early and current concession stand workers can communicate necessary information within 10 minutes.
- Please note the 7-day cancellation window.
- If you select the closing shift, you will need to stay until the concession stand is clean which is part of closing responsibilities.

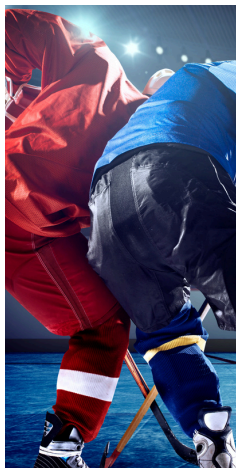
