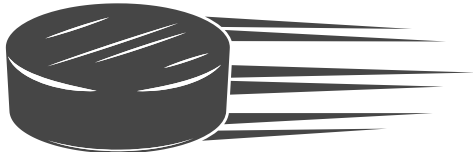
## FILL OPEN CONCESSION SHIFTS & GET PAID!

## NEW NECK GUARDS REQUIREMENT

*NOW EFFECTIVE - (8/1)*

- USA Hockey approved legislation requiring the use of neck laceration protection (neck guards) for players in all age classifications, other than adults.
- The new rule goes into effect August 1, 2024.
- Don't forget to purchase a neck guard for your child.
