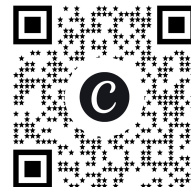

★ EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO SELL YOUR TICKETS ★

Every River Lakes family helps power the Mega Raffle. Here's how your ticket envelope works — and how you can earn [rewards for selling extra](#).

★ HOW YOUR ENVELOPE WORKS ★

1

YOU'LL GET AN ENVELOPE

At the start of the season every family receives an envelope with **40 Mega Raffle tickets** to sell at \$20 each.

2

SELL YOUR TICKETS

For each ticket sold, write the buyer's **name, address, & phone number** on the stub, keep the stub, and collect **\$20** — cash, check (payable to River Lakes Hockey).

3

TURN IT ALL BACK IN

By **Jan 5, 2027**, return your envelope to River Lakes Hockey Association with **all sold-ticket stubs** and **all cash & checks** inside.

✓ **ALL tickets and ALL money must come back to River Lakes Hockey Association.**

SELL MORE, WIN MORE

GO BEYOND YOUR 40

Sold all 40? Just ask your team manager for **another envelope** and keep going — the more you sell, the higher the **reward tier** you reach.

≈ \$30,000

If every family sells just **10 extra tickets**, that's about **\$30,000 more** for River Lakes hockey — and sell out all 7,500 tickets.

Everyone starts with 40 — sell beyond that to climb the reward tiers:

BRONZE

Sell 50 total · +10 extra

Stars swag, rink gift card or volunteer-hours credit

SILVER

Sell 65 total · +25 extra

Sporting-goods gift card or volunteer-hours credit

GOLD

Sell 90 total · +50 extra

Hockey-gear package or premium gift card

PLATINUM

Sell 115 total · +75 extra

Cash prize

NOV 5, 2026

ALL TICKETS & MONEY DUE
JAN 5, 2027

GRAND DRAWING (LIVE)
JAN 15, 2027

Checks payable to River Lakes Hockey. Must be 18 or older to purchase a ticket.
