



## **ROCKFORD HOCKEY CLUB UNIFORM POLICY**

The Rockford Hockey Club has the following policies for uniforms:

### Game Day

Teams will be required wear their RHC warm-ups to games. This includes all players. If the coaches and players agree this can be changed to dress pants, shirt and tie.

### Game Day On – Ice

Players will be required to purchase their home and away jerseys. These can be used for multiple seasons if they fit and are in good condition. RHC reserves the right to require a player to replace damaged jerseys.

Players will be required to wear hockey pant covers. Blue covers with white jersey and black covers with black jersey. All players will receive their first covers in both blue and black from the Club at no-charge. Any subsequent covers needed, will be the responsibility of the player to purchase through the Club. RHC reserves the right to require a player to replace damaged pant covers.

Players will be required to wear Club provided hockey socks. White socks with white jerseys and black socks with black jerseys. The first pair of each color will be provided by the Club for the season at no-charge. Any replacements will be the responsibility of the player to purchase through the Club. RHC reserves the right to require a player to replace damaged hockey socks.

Players will be required to wear blue helmets and blue gloves for all games.

### Practice – On Ice

Players are required to wear their Club issued practice jersey and practice socks for all practices. These will be provided by the Club. Any replacement practice jersey or practice socks will be the responsibility of the player to purchase through the Club. Players can wear their hockey pant covers for practice if they choose (either color), otherwise they will need to wear blue or black hockey pants. Players will be required to wear their blue helmets and blue gloves for practice.

### Out of Season

Players should not be wearing their game jerseys and hockey pant covers out of season (in-house, 4 on 4, spring development, etc.) without prior Board approval.
