



# **SYAA Santos Ultimate Shootout Challenge!**

Shootout will be held on 12/13 during Soccer with Santa with 2 time slots 10am to 12pm and 1pm to 3pm Finals are being held on Friday 12/19 at 6:30pm

- **1. Stations 5 shooting stations** with goals that get smaller each time.
  - 1. Large Goal 2 4'x6' Goals easiest
  - 2. Medium Goal 2 Pug Goals
  - 3. Small Goal 2 Flags 3' apart
  - 4. Mini Goal 2 Flags spaced the width of 2 #5 soccer Balls hardest

#### 2. Point Values

- Large Goal = 1 point
- Medium Goal = 3 points
- Small Goal = 5 points
- Mini Goal = 10 points

# 3. Number the Kids & Create a Flow

Keep lines moving smoothly:

- Give each child a numbered Sticker to compete.
  - For U10 players and up get a name and parents' phone number to contact winners who advance.
- Group them by age group.
  - o U6
  - o U8
  - o U10
  - o U12
  - o **U14**
  - And Up
- Ball Size:
  - U6 & U8 use a size 3 ball
  - o U10 & U12 use a size 4 ball
  - U14 & Up use a size 5 ball
- Each child will start at Station 1 and them rotate through all 4 stations.

#### 4. How the Round Works

Number of attempts:

- U6 to U10 1–3 attempts per station (if there isn't a large backup U6&U8 can get more attempts.)
- U12 and Up 1-2 attempts per station 4 attempts on the last goal.

### 5. Scorekeeping

Each division will have a separate score sheet for keeping track for U10 and Up.

For each player:

- U10 and Under everyone gets a participation ribbon. We will not keep score for U6 or U8.
- U10 and Up we will track the score to select the players that advance to the finals!
  - # of Goals scored at each station (cumulative so a U14 player makes both attempts in all the goals they would get 40 points total.)

# 6. Determining Finalists for U12 and Up

At the end of the day:

- Add all points
- Announce the Top 5 Scorers for each age group(U10,U12,U14&UP)
  - Parents will receive a text if their player advances to the finals.
  - o We will also send an email to the entire club announcing the Finalists!
- These players advance to the Final Round next Friday night December 19th at 630pm

### 7. Final Weekend — Full-Size Goal Shootout

Full size goal with a target screen:

Assign point values as follows:

- Upper corners = 10 points
- Lower corners = 5 points
- Left and right Middle = 3 points
- Center = 2 points
- Anywhere inside the frame hitting the post or the screen = 1 point

Each finalist gets **5 shots**.

Highest total wins in each division.



### 8. Awards

- Participation ribbons for U10 and Under
- U10 and Up will compete the following Friday night
  - o All Finalist will receive a certificate
  - 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive a Trophy
  - o 4th and 5th will receive a Medal
