**Park Board Update:** (Jordan) The fencing that was requested for additional storage at the Icon was approved. Funding for updates to the Purpur concessions facilities was also approved. Naming of the rinks at the BLC Iceplex was discussed. Architects will be presenting proposals on remodeling concessions, locker rooms, and bathrooms. Painting is done and new signage is going up in September.

**Girls Growth & Development Update:** (Margot) The girls program participated in the Potato Bowl Parade again this year, handing out flyers and candy, and had a good turnout. **Executive Director Update:** (Brad) Brad discussed the new goalie policy that was implemented which addressed the amount of rostered spots for goalies on each team. There was some parent feedback, but overall, it was well received. Registration for the 2025/2026 season is now open. Brad discussed the upcoming meeting with NDAHA. He wanted to propose leagues being divided by east/west (as opposed to north/south) which would greatly reduce travel for many of our teams. An email with a survey regarding this matter will go out to parents prior to the meeting to gauge feedback and a level of support.
