Mites will be divided by age into 2 groups

Mite 1- Players born between 6-01-18 and 5-31-19

Mite 2- Players born between 6-01-17 and 5-31-18

Start Date: November 2

End Date: February 13

We will have one coordinator for each Mite age level.

Our In-House programs rely on parent coaches. We ask for all that are able to please volunteer to help out. All parents interested in coaching must first fill out the coaching application that is on the GFYHA website. Coaches will then need to register as a volunteer with USA Hockey and finish all required forms or courses (SafeSport, background check etc.) before being on-ice. A players' volunteer requirement (DIBS) is waived if coach has fulfilled all requirements and has had regular attendance (+80%)

Each Mite level will begin the year skating in 2 groups. These groups will be divided alphabetically. Teams will then be divided equally by skill level after a few practices and families will get an email giving them instructions to pick up their team jersey from Gerrells. Practices and games will then be in teams for the rest of the season.

Practice days- Mites will have 2 practice days per week and one game day per week. Practice days will be on Mondays and Thursdays.

There may be a few weeks with alternate days due to ice restrictions.

In an effort to have preferred ice times multiple arenas are used

Game Days- Mites will play games on Saturday Mornings.

Schedules will be uploaded on the Crossbar app once players have been placed on a team roster.

The year will conclude with the annual IceBreaker Tournament. The IceBreaker will take place on February 12 and 13 (Friday and Saturday) . All players can expect to play one game Friday and two games on Saturday morning.
