

**Pinedale Glaciers High School Lettering Criteria  
2025-2026 Season**



Although ice hockey is not recognized as an official high school sport by the Wyoming High School Activities Association (WHSAA), the PHA Board is endorsing the following criteria for lettering.

Should a player be interested in receiving a letter/pin for his/her participation, **the player and his/her parents or guardians will need to sign the agreement and return it to the Coach or Manager prior to the first WAHL game of the season.**

The following is the criteria for lettering in hockey:

1. Must be of high school age and play on the PHA U19 Girls team or PHA HS team.
2. Attend and actively participate in 75% of all scheduled practices, including on-ice as well as any dry land training.
3. Attend and actively participate in 75% of all tournaments and games.
4. To be eligible to receive a letter, students must submit their Semester 1 grades, as well as their current grades at the end of the season. To qualify, students must pass all classes during Semester 1 and be passing all classes at the season's end.
5. Strict adherence to the USA Hockey Code of Conduct and the PHA Player's Code of Conduct.
6. Consistently represent the sport of Ice Hockey in a positive manner during all hockey functions, within the community, and at school by exhibiting good sportsmanship and proper behavior; school suspensions and/or expulsions will jeopardize letter.
7. A player will not be allowed to letter if any one of the following violations of the PHA Player's Code of Conduct occurs within the season: **Must be reported and documented to the PHA Board.**
  - a. **Disrespect** – being charged with a second offense
  - b. **Fighting, Profane or Abusive Language, Obscene Gestures** – being charged with a second offense
  - c. **On-Ice Game Conduct/Misconduct** – being charged with a second offense
  - d. **Tobacco Products** – being charged with a second offense
  - e. **Alcoholic Beverages, Controlled Substances (Drugs), Consumption/Use/Abuse of Mood-Altering Substances** – being charged with a second offense
  - f. **Confiscation (Stealing) or Destruction of Private or Public Property** – being charged with a first offense

***We understand that lettering is an earned privilege, not a right, and have read and agree to the above hockey lettering criteria.***
