Post Clinton Community College he planned to attend SUNY Plattsburgh to earn a Bachelors in the field of health science.

Kyle had a passion for hockey and especially enjoyed the experience of being a guest of the Boston Bruins and meeting the team at the TD Banknorth Garden in Boston.

Kyle lost his battle to Cancer in 2007.

About the Scholarship: In his memory North Country Youth Hockey selects applicants of the Kyle M. Cartier Memorial Scholarship every year to provide financial assistance to student(s) who plan to continue their vocational or collegiate education beyond Secondary Education.

The Guidance Department at the highschool will collect and forward all applications to a member of the selection committee by the end of May to ensure that the committee can review and render a decision prior to the NCCS Graduation Ceremony.

The NCYH Board of Directors award the selected applicant(s) with an amount to be determined (not to exceed \$500).

To be eligible the student(s) must meet the following criteria:

- Must have been a member of the NCYH Association for a minimum of five complete seasons.
