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Usage Rules

1) The primary purpose of this facility is to provide training and instruction to softball players.

Coaches are responsible for the safety of players within the facility. Following the basic guideline of *no hitting or throwing outside of cage areas should be followed*. For example:

- No Hitting soft toss / or tees into outside walls of cages.
- Do not warm up pitchers in open areas outside of cages and infield.
- No catcher drills and other fielding drills outside of cages and infield.

2) Metal and rubber cleats are not permitted on the field.

3) Coaches and players must utilize pitching and hitting mats to reduce wear and tear on turf.

4) Pitching machines should be aimed at the end of cages with additional protection (hanging black mat's). When not in use, pitching machines should either be removed from cages or protected by covering with turf or a net. Please place machine on rubber mat to protect floor turf.

5) Head coaches will be provided access codes to access the facility. Coaches are not authorized to share codes without approval from facility manager.

6) Since we are "co-tenants" with other tenants utilizing "shared" areas (parking, entrances, egress to our space) it is coaches' responsibility to ensure these areas are secured at the end of the night (lights turned off, doors secured, etc.)

7) No "loitering" in adjacent tenant spaces. These areas are off-limits and we need to be respectful of tenant property. It is the coaches and instructor's responsibility to ensure compliance.

8) Only coaches, approved instructors, players, parents, siblings associated with CTW or other authorized renters are allowed access to the facility.

9) Alcohol and smoking are prohibited on the premises.

10) No drinks, food, gum, or seeds is allowed on the turf. Players should consume drinks on the "Black" rubber mats" and not on primary practice turf.

11) No animals are permitted at the facility.

12) Security cameras have been installed to ensure compliance.

13) Coaches end of practice checklist includes:


- Returning all screens to designated areas
- Returning pitching machines to designated areas
- Bathrooms and Break room are clean, picked up and trash disposed of
- Break room door, facility door, and main entrance doors are locked, lights are off
- Unidentified equipment is left in designated lost and found area

Parking

The formal address of facility is 6704 Pingree, Crystal Lake, IL 60014. The entry is off Rickert Road off Pingree. An Ariel view is listed below.

The Blue areas 3 and 4 are the primary parking during weekdays before 7pm with the entrance located near the star.

Blue area 1 is parking available after 7pm and on weekends. Blue area 1 is not available during the day as it is the parking lot for General Kinematics employees.



Spectators

Spectators includes anyone not directly involved with practice and training of athletes (parents, siblings, friends, etc.) In order to provide a safe environment, we request spectators remain outside the facility.

Facility Flow and Organization

Coaches and players are requested to line up player backpacks, coats, and street shoes in an orderly manner when arriving to the facility for practice. These areas include the fences near the back entrance, the wall along cage 1, and the back wall by the bathrooms.

Speed and Agility Area

This area is available for individual and teams to improve athletic ability. Spectators should not be loitering in this area in order to keep the area open and available for usage. Players and coaches are expected to put all equipment (weights, medicine balls, ropes, etc.) away after use.

Storage Areas

Shelving units are available by the main entrance for coaches to store equipment. Units are assigned by the Facility Manager.

Scheduling Rules

Each team is assigned a practice schedule. As a common courtesy to other coaches and also to maximize utilization of the facility, coaches need to notify "Facility" Manager if they will not be using their assigned time slots. Coaches also need to be considerate of the schedule and vacate their practice space prior to the start of the next assigned time slots.

Team schedules are available to a shared file to coaches.

Evacuation Plans

There are 2 primary exits for the facility. The main entrance and also a secondary door by the security cage that leads to an outside exit. A third emergency is located along the back wall in the conference room.
