

2026 Prowl at the Peak Jamboree Official Jamboree Rules

The Jamboree will be held at Sertich Ice Arena 1705 E Pikes Peak Ave, Colorado Springs, CO 80909 January 23-25, 2026

1. REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE

- a. 8U& Under (Mite) Intermediate and Beginner Levels on all dates.
- b. USAH 1-T roster will be checked a minimum of 2 weeks prior to start of jamboree.

2. TOURNAMENT COST

- a. Registration fee is \$650 for beginner, \$700 for intermediate. Fees are per team, not each organization. Payment is due at time of registration payable via ACH, Debit or Credit Card. All entry fees will be deposited when received by the jamboree coordinator.
- b. Registration will close on January 10, 2026.
- c. If your team is not accepted a full refund will be issued in the same way it was paid by your team.

3. GAMES

- a. All USA Hockey Rules will apply except as modified below.
- b. USAH Officials are not required and will not attend at the 8U level. USA Hockey registered coaches shall act as on-ice officials with one coach for each team on ice during game time.
- c. Games will count toward the maximum allowed per ADM policies.
- d. Six 30-minute games per team are guaranteed.
- e. Format is as follows:
 - i. Blue pucks; 2 Minute shift clock.
 - ii. Goalies and standard net for half-ice intermediate games.
 - iii. No Goalies and mite nets for cross- ice beginner Games.
 - iv. No penalties.
 - v. All games will be 30 minutes in length
- f. Score will not be kept or posted in ESS.

4. TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. Host association will manage clock, all games are 30 minutes, with 2-minute shift
- b. Blue pucks will be provided by the host organization.
- c. Teams must check in half hour prior to start time and will receive locker room assignments.
- d. Teams are responsible for providing their own locker room monitors in accordance with affiliate rules and USA Hockey. Locker rooms will be assigned at Team checkin
- e. Teams encouraged to provide a light and dark color uniform and will be assigned uniforms colors upon check-in. If a team only has one color, PPHC must be notified in advance to plan for scheduling.

5. FORFEITS/REFUSAL TO PLAY

- a. Any team which enters a tournament and fails to appear on time for a scheduled Game or any Team (CAHA registered or otherwise) who fails to provide a valid T-1 roster to the Tournament Director prior to the first Game of the tournament will be subject to:
 - i. Forfeit all tournament Games as determined by the Tournament Director.
 - ii. Pay for all expenses, including but not limited to Referee fees and ice cost for each Forfeited Game.
 - iii. Denied entry in any Colorado tournaments for the remainder of the season and in the case of a CAHA team, any approved travel permits will be rescinded.

6. SAFE SPORT COMPLIANCE

a. The USAH Sanctioned Tournament Safe Sport Program Protocol will be adhered to.

7. NECK GUARDS

a. Neck guards are mandatory for all youth, girls, and adaptive players per USAH rules.
