TOURNAMENT RULES: 2025/2026 Season

Age Classification

8 & Under: Advanced, Intermediate, and Beginner

Location

Monument Ice Rinks - East or West Rinks 16240 Old Denver Rd Monument, CO 80132

Entry Fee

- The entry fee for the Jamboree for all levels will be posted on the Monument Rebels website.
- Fees must be paid online under the Tournament section of <u>Monument Rebels' Website</u>.
- Once accepted into the Jamboree, the entry fee is non-refundable.
- There is no admission fee for spectators.
- If your team is not accepted, the entry fee will be refunded by Dec 1, 2025.

General Information

- All players must be registered with USA Hockey.
- USA Hockey playing rules will apply.
- This is a USA Hockey-sanctioned tournament, and the SafeSport Program Protocol will be followed.

Credentials

- A manager or coach must present complete credentials before the first Jamboree game.
- Each team must provide a USA Hockey 1-T Roster at least two weeks before the tournament.

Game Format

- Intermediate: Games will be played 4v4 with a goalie on half-ice using an intermediate net.
- **Beginner**: Games will be played 4v4, no goalie, on a mini-net, cross-ice.
- Each game includes a 2-minute warm-up followed by a running 26-minute period, with a buzzer for line changes every 2 minutes.
- Each team will play six (6) 26-minute games.
- Time-outs are not permitted.
- Each team must provide one coach on the ice to officiate.
- No score will be kept.
- No tie-breakers will be applied since scores are not kept.
- Game pucks (blue) will be provided by the Colorado Rampage.
 - o Warm-up pucks will need to be provided by individual teams.
- Game results will NOT be posted on CAHA's electronic scoring system.

Jerseys

• All players must wear a jersey in the proper team color. If there are home and away jerseys for the team, bring both sets of jerseys to each game.

Equipment

Neck guards are required for all players at all levels.

Benches

- Only USA Hockey-certified coaches and players are allowed on the bench.
- All players on the bench must wear a helmet with a full face mask per USA Hockey rules.
- One coach from each team will officiate the games; coaches must be USA Hockey certified.
- Older USA Hockey-registered players may be permitted to volunteer as officials.

Disputes/Refusal to Play

- No protests regarding game times will be allowed. Disputes over results are not applicable as scores are not kept.
- If a team refuses to play a scheduled game, their payment will be forfeited, and they will be removed from the tournament.

Damage to Facilities

- Teams are responsible for any willful property damage. Costs for repairs or replacements must be paid immediately to rink management.
- Abusive behavior toward rink personnel will result in ejection from the rink and the jamboree.

Locker Rooms

- Locker rooms will be available, but it is the responsibility of coaches and managers to monitor them according to USA Hockey SafeSport guidelines.
- A representative should be present at least 20 minutes before your scheduled ice session.
- Teams may enter locker rooms 15 minutes before their session. Players are encouraged to arrive dressed for their events.
- Monument Ice Rinks or its staff nor Colorado Rampage Youth Hockey assumes any responsibility for the loss/theft/damage of any personal property left in the locker rooms or the rink grounds including parking lots.
- Consumption of food and beverages is not allowed in the locker rooms.

Arrival Times

Teams should arrive at the rink at least one hour before their game and be ready to play 10 minutes before their scheduled game time.
