ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE
ALBERT LEA AMATEUR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be the ALBERT LEA AMATEUR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II.

This corporation is organized under the provisions of Chapter 550 of Minnesota Laws, 1951 (M.S.A., Sections 317.07-317.78).

ARTICLE III.

The purpose of this corporation shall be to promote interest in amateur hockey; to provide instruction and training for youth interested in a hockey program; to promote and provide social and athletic recreation for its members; and to provide hockey games among its own members and members of other similarly constituted organizations for the benefit, enjoyment, instruction and well being of its members.

ARTICLES IV.

The corporation does not, or shall not, afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise, to its members.

ARTICLE V.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI.

The registered office of the corporation shall be in the City of Albert Lea, County of Freeborn, State of Minnesota.
