- Agreements
 - Rink
 - Agreement Signed Earlier this month - Rates go from \$275 per hour to \$300. First increase in a long while
 - Officials
 - Two-year agreement we are entering the second and final year. Rates Stay the same.
 - Medics-Presnar
 - Presnar will continue to schedule and manage the Medics for no fee
 - Rate adjustment
 - Non Checking Games stay \$50
 - Checking Games go from \$50 to \$65. This reflects the longer time commitments 65 vs 85 minutes and the complexity.
 - Skating – Mel
 - Mel will be back in the same capacity for all teams this year and stay at the same rate
 - Goaltending
 - JT sent a letter declining his services to LCL this year. This was not our desire and was totally his decision
 - We have interest from Kenny Shoup to step into this role. Proposal was emailed to the board.
 - Shoup proposal was accepted unanimously by the board
 - Registrar
 - Had agreed to let Amy Johns carry on as the registrar even though she had no kids left in org. She wanted a small fee. Board agreed in April
 - Amy Johns is not responding to email and phone attempts to reach
 - Amy has responded and we are in the process of getting both her and Ilia setup as registrars for this year
- VP
 - Todd read some topics from the league meeting pertinent to coaches
- Finance
 - Year end Financials
 - Checking Balance - \$28,400.09
 - CD Balance - \$37,081.32
 - Total- \$64,481.41
 - Difference of (\$2,071.94) to LY

- Uncollectable
 - Current Balance - \$412.50
- Projections for 26/27
 - The preliminary budget projects a (\$11,663) shortfall.
 - \$8,962 in extra ice fees
 - Compressed PAHL schedule help
 - Lower player counts
 - Last year we were able to secure \$11,000 in donations. Only the \$2,500 we got from Joy for mite jerseys is in budget right now
- Organizational fundraising – An alternative to straight dues
 - Vacation Raffle is budgeted
 - This is a dues offset with payment by families upfront.
 - You don't have to sell tickets, but you owe the money. You can at least turn tickets in and have a chance to win.
- Donations
 - Joy Baking Group -\$2500 donation to sponsor "new player" mite jerseys again.
- Dues
 - Board will review the budget spreadsheet Brent sent. Will set dues at next meeting.

- Secretary
 - 316k facebook views
- ADM
 - Tracking better than last year. Have 20 mites
 - Great participation in Lil' Lighting – 40 plus
 - Looking to roll that group into Little Pens then to Mites

 - Ice Scheduling – Corey will manage the slots, managers/coaches can reach out to him to schedule PAHL games. Brent will communicate to rink.
