Four new curtains and new bearings for zamboni auger are on the way. The rink needs to be closed 10 AM to 6 PM to keep the ice. Peewees, Bantams, HS need priority since they still have competitions.

This spring we should write a job description. Robert will get that started for us. The role is 20-25 hours a week. There are a few refrigeration companies that may be willing to come service the equipment.

New Business

- Chamber of Commerce – Abi Beers

Abi would like SHA to become a member of the Chamber of Commerce; it would cost \$95/year as non-profit. SHA would be in the new chamber trifold visitor guide and eligible to be included in future ITC grants (derived from 2% of all visitor lodging) - Abi anticipates being funded by the grant this year.

- Curling stones

We are going to think about this. Robert's concern is that painted ice melts faster.

- Snack Shack - Mallori

On behalf of Cait Cole: \$32k from the Snack Shack (66% were from credit cards). We should buy some chairs for the snack shack. Can get a 4 pack for \$128.

Motion made, seconded, passed to buy 16 chairs for the snack shack - will look into pricing for local options first.

Mallori - will look into pricing for carpet cleaning in Snack Shack, and whole building deep clean.

On February 26 via text message - Board voted to hire Kayte Schroff for a deep clean of the Snack Shack and bathrooms for \$150.

- PBR tournament - Andy

This year's PBR Tournament was a success with the same number of teams, warm weather, though they sold less beer. In the past they were charged a tournament fee by SHA, more recently it was a donation (for the rink upgrade). This year they gave a donation in a check given to Amy.

Mallori thought it might be good to do an MOU to make sure everyone is on the same page about SHA/PBR. Frances will make it and work with Andy.

Andy is hoping to host a second adult tournament with the new longer ice schedule - 40+ coed (end of season or beginning of season). We need to add this to our conversation about next year's schedule

Adults would like to take charge of the golf tournament.

Motion made, seconded, passed to let the adults take charge of the golf tournament fundraiser.
