Motion made, seconded, passed to approve November 19, 2025 meeting minutes.

Reports

President Report

Tires were removed but the county would not waive the fee and Fred Snook paid it.

VP Report

Haven't yet talked to Amy about a replacement Treasurer.

Treasurer Update

Amy emailed a report. Revenue including tournaments, registration and advertising are consistent with prior years.

Rink Manager Update

The ice has been great despite warm weather; would not have been able to hold last week's tournament without the new system.

The penalty box cannot be moved again. We could tear the roof off to extend it out, that will be something we need a builder to do. Chris suggests forming a penalty box planning committee.

Robert thinks we should insulate the south end boards and cover them with FRP. Lemhi Lumber quote for FRP is \$938.40 and \$815.84 for insulation. Volunteers would need to install.

Motion made, seconded, passed to spend up to \$2000 to insulate the south end of the rink ASAP.

Ten new shades would be \$8600. The current shades have lasted 10-15 years. At least five shades need to be fixed or replaced this year.

Motion made, seconded, passed to purchase 5 new shades for approximately \$4500. We will revisit this in the spring for remaining shades and posts.

Robert said kids are getting into the locker rooms when they are not supposed to so he will change the code to the zam shed where the keys are stored.

Locker rooms and toilets are all fixed.

Lights need to be turned off by 11 PM. We will need to revisit the agreement with the city to see if there is a set time in the morning that rink use can begin. We discussed this and feel it would be reasonable to open skating from 7 AM to 4 PM Monday through Thursday, aside from other scheduled events. Anyone who uses lights needs to turn them off when they are done.

Rink Upgrade Committee Report

In the process of finding someone to do the compressor rebuilds.

Registrar

Mallori said the IAHA State Registrar sent tournament rules templates which she will send out.

We need to remind coaches that play-ups take a while (at least 1 week) as they need signatures and to be sent to the state.

Tournament Manager

Most teams have paid. Mallori tried the Crossbar tournament features, which we could use in the future for other tournaments.

Advertisement Coordinator

We have 22 small signs, 31 large signs sold for a total of \$14,600. We made a plan to begin putting up the signs Sunday at 2 PM, finishing on Monday at 2 PM.
