Logistics:

- Practices: details will be published soon on our website
 - March 9- April 10
 - 8U and 10U teams practice 2x/week, 60 min/practice, Location TBD
 - 12U and 14U practice 2x/week, 90 min/practice outside KEVA Sports Center 8312 Forsythia St, Middleton, WI 53562
 - After April 10 (or when Madison Parks open)
 - 8U and 10U teams practice 2x/week, 60 min/practice Garner Park
 - 12U and 14U teams practice 2x/week, 90 min/practice, Garner Park
- Games
 - BLA Games: Each team plays two games per week April 19-May 23. Girls typically play Saturday mornings and Boys typically play Sunday mornings.
 - Tournaments: Each team can play up to 2 tournaments; there are no additional fees to play in tournaments.
 - Badger Invite, Wisconsin Dells, April 25 (Girls) and April 25 (Boys)
 - Norski Lacrosse Tournament, May 30 (Girls) and May 31 (Boys)
- Player Attendance Expectations
 - While we understand players have multiple interests, we ask players to attend as many practices as they can to develop their skills as an individual and teammate. Tell the coach if your player will not be able to attend practice.
 - Please try to attend all of the games and tournaments. The spring lacrosse season is very short so there is limited time for games and the team is strongest with all the players present. If your player needs to miss a game, please let the coach know as soon as possible.
